1. General Qualifications required :

1:1 Every applicant must furnish satisfactory proof that he is a Sri Lankan. A Sri Lankan, is a citizen of Sri Lanka by descent or by registration as defined in the Sri Lanka Citizenship Act.

1:2 A candidate for any post for which the minimum educational qualification prescribed is a pass in the Senior School Certificate Examination or equivalent or higher examination, should have a pass in the Senior School Certificate Examination or equivalent or higher examination, should have a pass either in Sinhala language or Tamil language obtained, as the case may be, at the Senior School Certificate Examination or its equivalent if he is either a Sinhalese educated in Sinhala Medium or if he is a Tamil educated in Tamil Medium (This requirement will not apply to those who are in the public service from a date prior to January 01, 1961, and who seek appointments to other posts in the public service).

1:3 Application from the New Entrants, Public Officers, who are not either Sinhala or Tamil educated, whose probationary trial appointments have been terminated for failure to pass the prescribed official language proficiency tests will not be entertained unless they have obtained the qualifications which could entitle them to seek exemptions from the highest proficiency test prescribed for the post.

2. Conditions of Service-General :

2:1 All officers in the Public Service will be subject to the Financial Regulations, the Establishments Code, Departmental Orders or Regulations and any other Orders or Regulations that may be issued by the Governments from time to time.

2:2 A Public officer may be required to furnish security in terms of the Public Officers (Security) Ordinance, in such sum and in such manner as the secretary to the Ministry concerned may determine.

2:3 A Public Officer may be called upon to serve in any part of the Island.

3. Conditions of Service applicable to Public Officers holding permanent appointments :

3:1 In addition to the conditions referred to in Section 2 above Public Officer holding permanent appointments will be subject to the following further conditions:

3:1:1 All appointments will be on probation for a period of 3 years unless a longer period is considered necessary in respect of any post. Any appointment may be terminated at any time during the period of probation without a reason being assigned.

3:1:2 All public officers are required to conform to the provisions of the Chapter IV of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka and any other laws, regulations or rules that may be made from time to time to give effect to the Language Policy of the Government.

3:1:3 All Public officers who have not entered the Public Service either in Sinhala Medium or in Tamil Medium are required to acquire a working knowledge in one of the official languages.

3:1:4 Confirmation at the expiry of the period of probation of an officer who entered the Public Service in a medium other than Sinhala or Tamil will depend, inter alia, on the passing of the Grade I Proficiency Test in one of the Official Languages within one year; Grade II Proficiency Test within two years, and Grade III Proficiency Test (where applicable) within three years from the date of appointment.

Failure to pass a test within the prescribed period will result in the suspension of increments. Suspension will be converted to a stoppage if the test is not passed within a further period of six months beyond the prescribed period such stoppage operating until the test is passed or until such time as the provisions of Section 3:1:6 below apply.

3:1:5 Such officers should, on receiving appointment, be given facilities on full pay, for a period of 6 months to obtain proficiency in one of the official languages. He will thereafter, be required to sit the relevant proficiency examination and if he does not pass he will be given the opportunity to pass the examination within a period of 2 years immediately after the period of 6 months on full pay, while he performs his normal duties.

3:1:6 If he fails to pass the examination in this prescribed period of 2 1/2 years his services will be terminated.

3:1:7 A Public Officer already confirmed in permanent post in the Public Service will not normally be required to serve the period of probation on being appointed to another permanent post in the Public Service. Such Officers may in the first instance be appointed to act in the new post for a

specified period with a view to testing him in his new post.

3:1:8 Selected candidates (Other than those already holding permanent or temporary appointments in the Public Service) who have already been medically examined will be required to undergo a medical examination by a Government Medical Officer to test their physical fitness to serve in any part of the Island.

4. Terms of Engagement :

4:1 Public officers appointed to permanent and pensionable posts should contribute to the 'Widows and Orphans' Pension Scheme from their salary an amount equivalent to the percentage the Government requires to recover from their salary.

4:2 Public officers appointed to permanent or temporary posts on Provident Fund basis will be required to contribute 6% of their consolidated salary to the Public Service Provident Fund. The Government will contribute as its share of contributions an amount equal to 150% of the compulsory contributions credited to the fund at the close of the Financial Year.

4:3 Officers who hold pensionable appointments in the Public Service and who are released for appointments to pensionable posts in the Local Government Service and those officers in the Local Government Service who hold pensionable appointments and who are released for appointments to pensionable posts in the Public Service will be allowed pensionability in their posts in the Local Government Service and Public Service respectively.

4:4 Regular Force personnel in the Army, Navy and Air Force who are released for appointments to posts in the Public Service which are pensionable under the Minutes on Pension will be allowed pensionability in their posts in the Public Service. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in these Minutes the unforfeited full pay service of any member of the Armed Forces who is released to accept an appointment as a Public Officer in a post which has been declared to be pensionable under these Minutes shall be reckoned for the purpose of any pension or gratuity payable under these Minutes.

5. Serving Officers in the Public Service :

5:1 Applications from officers of the Public Service who possess all the necessary qualifications must be forwarded through the Heads of their respective Departments. In the case of applications from Public Officers holding post in the permanent establishment in the Public Service. Heads of Departments in forwarding such applications should state whether the applicants could be released or not to take up the new appointment, if selected.

5:2 Candidates may be required to present themselves for interview at an appointed time and place. No travelling or other expenses will be paid in this connection.

5:3 Anyone desiring to recommend a candidate should do so by giving a testimonial. Any form of canvassing or any attempt to influence the selection of a candidate will disqualify such candidates.

5:4 Any statement in the application which is found to be incorrect will render the applicant liable to disqualification if the inaccuracy is discovered before the selection and to dismissal if discovered after the selection.

5:5 Application not conforming in every respect with the requirements of the advertisement will be rejected.

6. Definition of Salary for the purpose of Eligibility :

6:1 Salary for purposes of eligibility means only the consolidated salary and does not include any action salary, allowances etc.

7. New National Policy on Recruitment and Promotions :

Recruitment and Promotion in the Public Service, Provincial Public Service, Public Corporate Sector and Companies fully owned by the Government will be done in accordance with the policy laid down in the Public Administration Circulars No. 15/90 of 09.03.1990, 15/90 (I) of 25.03.1990 & 15/90 (ii) of 15.06.1990 with effect from 01.01.1990 subject to amendments that will be done by subsequent Public Administration Circulars.

RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR EXAMINATION CANDIDATES

THE Set of rules any Instructions Published under the title 'Rules and Instructions for examination Candidates' in all previously published *Gazette* notifications is hereby revoked, and henceforth the set of rules and Instructions published in this *Gazette* shall be in force.

All examination candidates are bound to act in compliance with the provisions of the Public Examinations Act, No. 25 of 1968 which was amended by No. 19 of 1976 and other rules and regulations imposed from time to time.

The following conditions and restrictions are hereby imposed through the Sentence No. 20 of the Public Examinations Act, No. 25 of 1968 which was amended through No. 19 of 1976 as per the powers assigned to the Commissioner General of Examinations.

All Examination candidates are bound to *abide by* the rules given below and a candidate who violates any of these rules is liable to one or more of the following penalties mentioned below at the discretion of the Commissioner General of Examinations:

- I. Debarring to appear for the whole examination or part of it which was under investigation.
- II. Disqualifying from one subject or from the whole examination which was under investigation.
- III. Imposing lifetime ban for all the examinations conducted by the Department of Examinations, Sri Lanka.
- IV. Department from appearing for examinations conducted by the Department of Examinations, Sri Lanka for a certain period of time.
- V. Issuing a letter with suspended Department of examination.
- VI. Suspension of the certificate for a specific period.
- VII. Handing over the examination candidate to the police to file a criminal case under the Public Examinations Act or complaining the police regarding such act.
- VIII. When the examination candidate is a Government employee reporting the appointing authority of such examination candidate (to take disciplinary actions) regarding the conduct of such examination candidate.

The Commissioner General of Examination reserves himself the right to take actions with respect of such examination candidate prior to during or after the examination or at any stage.
His decision with respect to that should be deemed final.

1. Every examination candidate should act in the examination hall and at the examination premises in such a manner that any disturbance or obstruction should not take place for the examination supervisor and his staff as well as for other examination candidates. Moreover, examination candidates should not vandalize the property of the examination premises or damage the private property of the examination staff.

2. Examination candidates should act in compliance with the instructions given by the examination supervisor and his staff when the examination is in progress and before the commencement of the examination as well as immediately after the end of the examination.

3. No examination candidate will be admitted to the examination hall after the lapse of half an hour subsequent to the commencement of the question paper at the examination. Also, no examination candidate will be permitted to leave the examination hall until the examination ends. Actions should be taken to participate for practical tests or oral tests on time.

4. Every examination candidate should sit on the seat reserved for him/her bearing the respective Index Number and not any other seat. Unless with the special permission of the examination supervisor, no candidate should change his/her seat. The occupation of a seat other than the one assigned to him/her is liable to be considered as an act committed with dishonest intention.

5. Absolute silence should be maintained in the examination hall. A candidate is forbidden to speak to or exchange messages or to have any dealing with any person within or outside the examination hall for any matter other than a member of the examination hall staff.

6. Since the answer script of an examination candidate will be solely identified through the candidate's Index Number, it is completely prohibited to write one's name on the answer script, put a certain mark or note to distinguish the answer script, write indecent or unnecessary things on the answer script and attaching currency notes with the answer script. Further, writing other examination candidate's Index Number on one's answer script could be considered as an attempt to commit a dishonest act. Answer scripts bearing Index Numbers those are difficult to decipher are liable to be rejected.

7. Examination candidates should not write on question paper or desk or any other place except on the papers (paper given to answer with in invigilator's short signature and the date with regard to the day on which the examination is conducted supplied at the examination hall. Acting non-compliance with these instructions will be considered as an act committed with dishonest intention.

8. Any paper or answer books supplied to examination candidates should not be torn up or crushed. Each and every sheet of paper used for rough work should be clearly crossed out and attached to the answer script or submitted with the answer script at the end of the examination or the candidate should do the needful as per the given instructions. It is forbidden to take out anything written inside the examination hall. If a question has been answered twice in two different places, the unnecessary answer should be clearly crossed out.

9. It is forbidden to take out the papers or any other material supplied to answer at the examination out of the examination hall. All such materials are belonged to the Commissioner General of Examinations and breach of this rule will be considered as a punishable act.

10. When examination candidates appear for the examination in the examination hall. They should not keep in their possession or by their side other note books, papers with notes or paper pieces except the stationery supplied to them for answering at the examination and the materials which were authorized in written for each examination. Also, keeping mobile phones, electronic communication instruments/ devices in one's possession or by one's side and obtaining assistance from external parties through such instruments/ devices and sending information to other parties and social media while the examination is in progress are considered to be dishonest acts and punishable offences.

11. In case electronic communication instruments/ devices are revealed to be used for the purpose mentioned in the above paragraph no 10, such instruments/ devices will be taken into the custody of the Commissioner General of Examination until the investigations are concluded.

12. After sitting in the examination hall an examination candidates is strictly forbidden to keep any unauthorized material or instrument in his/her possession prior to the examination or when the examination is in progress. In case the supervisor of the examination staff orders, each candidate is bound to declare everything he/she has with him/her and get them checked. Breach of these requirements should be considered as an attempt to commit an act of dishonesty.

13. It is an offence. In case a candidate copies or attempts to copy from the answer script of another candidate or a book or a script or a paper containing notes or through signals or any other source or acts dishonestly. Also, helping another candidate and getting held from another candidate or a person or exam staff are also offences and every completed answer sheet should be kept underneath the sheet on which the answer is being written papers should not be strewn all over the desk.

14. A candidate will under no circumstance whatsoever be allowed to leave the examination hall even for a brief period during the course of the paper after the commencement of the examination. However, in case an examination candidate needs to go outside for a brief period under the surveillance of an officer belongs to the to the assistant staff of the examination supervisor. He/She shall be subject to search before leaving the examination hall as well as when re-entering it.

15. Impersonation before commencement of answering at the examination hall or after is a punishable act. Tempering with identity cards or presenting false identity card is considered to be an act of dishonesty.

16. Assistance given to a candidate in an improper and dishonest manner by a candidate or a person, who is not a candidate, is considered to be a serious offence.

17. Examination candidate should adhere to the following instructions.

I. Every examination candidate should take actions to the signature in their admission paper attested and get the subjects amended prior to the examination. after inquiring the Department of Examinations. Sri Lanka in case there is any discrepancy between the subjects applied and the subjects applied and the subject indicated in the admission paper.

II. It is appropriate to arrive the examination hall. half an hour prior to the commencement of the examination and if you are not quite certain of the location of the examination hall make inquiries on a day prior to the date of examination and be sure of its exact location.

III. Candidate should produce their identity cards and get their identities confirmed at every paper they sit when appearing for the examination.

- (a) Actions will be taken to cancel the candidature in case a candidate fails to produce the identification documents at the examination hall and in case a candidate forgets to bring such documents into the examination hall, that fact should be brought to the notice of the supervisor and arrangements should be made to produce them before the examination ends.
- (b) Every candidate should be in the examination hall during the examination period in such a way that his/her face should be clearly recognizable to display his/her identity in a clearly visible manner.

IV. Examination candidates should keep their ears openly and in a clearly visible manner so as to confirm that they are not using electronic communication instruments/ devices like Bluetooth.

V. No paper other than those issued at the examination hall should be used for answering questions. Excess paper and other materials should be left on your desk in good condition in a reusable manner.

VI. Examination candidates should bring their own pens, pencils, erasers, foot rulers, geometrical instruments, boxes of coloured pencils and boxes of coloured chalks, etc.

VII. When you start answering, you should promptly write down the Index Number clearly on the answer book used and each sheet of paper. Write answers clearly and legibly on both sides of the paper. You should leave at least a single blank line after providing the answer to a part of a question before starting to answer the next part of such question. You should provide answers in a fresh page for each question.

VIII. The left-hand margin of the answer sheet is set apart to enter the question number. Since the right-hand margin is reserved for the examiner's use, nothing should be written there. Actions should be taken to number the question you answered correctly as incorrect numbering leads to confusion.

IX. When mathematical questions are answered, give all details of calculations and any rough work in their serial order as part of the solving of the sum. The sketches and diagrams drawn in the relevant places should be accurate and sufficiently large.

X. You should read carefully the instructions given at the head of the questions paper with regard to the compulsory questions and the other questions which should be selected. Marks will not be granted for answers provided disregarding the given instructions in the question paper.

XI. At the end of answering for each question, in addition to the answer book use, the answer sheets should be collected according to the page number and then should be tied/ attached at the top left-hand corner in a non-detachable manner. Make sure whether you have attached all the answer sheets prior to handing over the answer script. Any answer sheet taken out of the examination centre will not be evaluated after the handing over of such answer scripts.

XII. Your answer scrip should be handed over to the examination supervisor or to an officer of his/her staff. You should remain in your seat until the answer scripts are collected. Failure to do so may result in the loss of your answer script and your being treated as an absentee for a certain subject.

XIII. If it becomes necessary for you to speak to the examination supervisor or an officer of his/her staff due to a certain matter, you should sing him by tapping two times on the desk without disturbing others.

(Ordinary Level) Examination in not more than two (02) sittings , with Credit passes in two subjects including Sinhala or Tamil language, and passes in six subjects including Religion and Mathematics.

c. Tradesman:

- (1) Basic Educational Qualifications - Should have passed Grade 10 or Grade 05 of Piriven Education. Further, in addition to the basic qualifications, the educational qualifications of applicants who have obtained the National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) levels will be considered as follows. Applicants possessing the NVQ certificates will also be recruited as professional apprentices in the Army. (Educational qualifications may differ for each profession)

d. Qualifications and Experience required for Tradesman:

(c) Successful completion of 03 months certificate course related to the profession from an institute recognised by the Government or Government-registered institution.
(d) Having a minimum of six months of experience related to the profession is considered a special qualification.
- (2) **Driver (Motor Transport)** - All Regiments:
- (a) Private (Male) - Not less than 18 years and not more than 26 years as at 31 December 2026.
(b) Should have the basic educational qualifications.
(c) Possession of heavy or light vehicle driving license.
(d) Should have a minimum of 06 months of driving experience in a Government or Government-registered institution.
(e) Candidates having knowledge or experience in automobile repairs will be considered as a special qualification.
- (3) **Administrative Assistant** - All Regiments (Except Sri Lanka Army Medical Corps):
- (a) Private (Male/Female) - Not less than 18 years and not more than 26 years as at 31 December 2026.
(b) Should have passed six (06) subjects at the G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination in not more than two (02) sittings, including Sinhala or Tamil language and Mathematics, with Credit passes in two (02) subjects.
(c) Should have completed at least 03 months of a Sinhala or English Typing Course in a Government or Government-registered Institution.
(d) Appearing for the G.C.E. (A/L) and proficiency in the English language will be considered as special qualifications.
- (4) **Material Management Assistant** - All Regiments (Excluding Corps of Engineer services, Sri Lanka Army Medical Corps, Sri Lanka Army Service Corps):
- (a) Private (Male/Female) - Not less than 18 years and not more than 26 years as at 31 December 2026.
(b) Must have passed six (06) subjects at the G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination in not more than two (02) sittings, including Sinhala or Tamil language and Mathematics, with Credit passes in two (02) subjects.
(c) Completion of a Storekeeper Course or an equivalent qualification, along with a Sinhala or English typing course and a computer course.
(d) Having 06 months of experience in warehousing will be considered a special qualification.

(5) **Carpentry Assistant** - All Regiments:

- (a) Private (Male) - Not less than 18 years and not more than 26 years as at 31 December 2026.
- (b) Should have the basic educational qualifications.
- (c) Having completed a 03 months career related course in a Government or Government-registered institution or having completed a career related NVQ LEVEL III or higher certificate course.
- (d) Having a minimum of 06 months of service experience in the profession will be considered a special qualification.

(6) **Cultural Dancing Troops** - All Regiments:

- (a) Private (Male) - Not less than 18 years and not more than 26 years as at 31 December 2026); Private (Female) - Not less than 18 years and not more than 22 years as at 31 December 2026.
- (b) Should have the basic educational qualifications.
- (c) Should have completed certified Eastern and Western dancing courses.
- (d) Recruitment will be based on the recommendation of the Commanding Officer of the Sri Lanka Army Cultural Band after the preliminary interview.

(7) **Armoured Vehicle Gunner Operator** - Sri Lanka Armoured Corps, Mechanized Infantry Regiment:

- (a) Private (Male) - Not less than 18 years and not more than 26 years as at 31 December 2026.
- (b) Should have the basic educational qualifications.

(9) **Artillery Technician Assistant** - Sri Lanka Artillery:

- (b) Should have passed 06 subjects, including Sinhala and Mathematics, in the G.C.E. (O/L) examination with Credit passes for two (02) subjects in not more than two attempts.

(10) **Field Engineer Assistant** - Corps of Sri Lanka Engineers:

- (a) Private (Male) - Not less than 18 years and not more than 26 years as at 31 December 2026.

Applications are called from eligible Sri Lankan citizens to recruit for the Training Courses of Para Medical Service, of the Ministry of Health and Mass Media from 07.08.2026 to 31.08.2026. Applications should be submitted only through the official web site of this Ministry (www.health.gov.lk).

1. **Important:**

- 1.1. Each applicant can submit only one application. If an applicant has submitted more than one application, all applications will be rejected. An applicant who has passed GCE A/L in 2019, 2020, 2021, 2022 and 2023 should submit only one application. The applicant should submit only one application based on the preferred year of examination. Applicant should not submit separate applications for the separate years. If an applicant has submitted separate applications for separate years all applications will be rejected without any notice.
- 1.2. In the past few years, considering recruitment, it was observed that many other qualified students did not get even one such opportunity due to the registration of several courses by one student under the free education privileges of the government. Apart from this, the government's money is being wasted due to this situation, and the planned goals of the relevant institutions cannot be achieved due to the lack of the expected number of trained professionals at the end of course. Therefore, necessary provisions to mitigate this situation and give every applicant at least one opportunity have been published in paragraph 6 of this *gazette*. Accordingly, as detailed in sub-paragraphs number 6.1 to 6.5, a person who is not eligible, should not apply for this course. However, if a person with such disqualification applies for this course and is discovered later, action will be taken against them as per sub-paragraph 7.3 of the *gazette* notification.
- 1.3. In past recruitments, it was observed that false information (false examination years, subjects, grades obtained etc.) was submitted in the applications. It has also been observed some applicants provide certificates with false information to the interview board. It is a serious offense. Therefore, no applicant should provide false information in the submitted e-application. If an applicant submits such false information the application will be rejected, applicants name will be submitted to Department of Criminal Investigation for necessary legal actions. Further their names will be included in the blacklisted names for recruiting to government service.
- 1.4. Each applicant should read and understand this gazette and the information provided in the e- application. 4. Method of recruitment for training:

4.1. Recruitment will be done from eligible applicants as per the recruitment procedures for the posts of Para Medical Service and the amendments made thereto from time to time, and the order of priority of the marked courses will be based on the applicants' Z score of G.C.E. (A/L) examination will also be considered and selected for one training course only.

4.2. The number to be recruited for training is determined by taking into account the predicted number of vacancies, training capacity, facilities available in training schools, current financial and other specific conditions in the country, and the total number to be recruited from the island is the population of each province. Based on that, the number to be recruited from each province will be divided in proportion to the population.

4.3. Thereafter the number to be recruited from each province will be divided in proportion to the number of applicants who apply from the respective province in each examination and have satisfied the minimum qualifications, and then number of recruits in each examination from the respective province will be determined.

4.4. Then, the number to be recruited in each examination is divided proportionally to the number of applicants who have applied from the bio science stream and physical science stream of the examination and completed the minimum qualifications, and the order of the courses marked among the applicants who have obtained the highest Z score under each subject stream of each examination from the respective province is also taken into account and selected on a provincial basis.

4.5. In case of non-completion of the vacancies by qualified candidates for a province, those vacancies will be re-distributed among the other provinces of the island in proportion to the population of those provinces.

Note:

(a). Each applicant must be enrolled in the course selected as per paragraph 4.1. and they will not be given the opportunity to enroll or transfer to another course.

(b). Also, by selecting students once again, for students who are not registered in a course, in order to avoid a crisis situation arising from their exchange between courses, students will be selected only once, and students will not be enrolled again in any course.

5.2. Applicant should be excellent in character and be physically and mentally fit.

5.3. You should have been a permanent resident of the district for three consecutive years immediately prior to the closing date of applications i.e.31.08.2026. The Certificate of residence issued by the Grama Niladhari should be submitted. 6.1. Students who are registered or currently following any fulltime/internal course conducted by a state university or a state university college recognized by the University Grants Commission under the **national free education policy**, that demands G.C.E. (A /L) qualifications.

6.2. Students who are registered or currently following any fulltime course conducted by a National College of Education of Sri Lanka, that demands G.C.E. (A /L) qualifications.

6.3. Students who are registered or currently following any fulltime course conducted by the Ministry of Health or any other government institute, that demands G.C.E. (A /L) qualifications.

6.4. If you have registered for a full-time course conducted by an institute which falls under 6.1, 6.2 or 6.3 above; even though, you cancelled your registration after the publication of this Gazette or after the interview, you are not eligible to apply or to get selected for the training.

6.5. A student who has registered the marriage or a divorcee. (This only applies to the School Dental Therapist Training Course)

7. Other Information:

- 7.1. If you have completed a degree in any University, the effective date should be a date which is earlier than the date of application i.e., 07.08.2026 to the course.
- 7.2. It should be strictly noted that no section contained in this Gazette notification implies that you will be selected to the course/courses applied for even the above conditions have been fulfilled. It should also be noted even if you have satisfied the above conditions, you are not eligible for above course, if you have not obtained a sufficient Z score to be eligible or if you have not fulfilled any other condition.
- 7.3. Subsequent to the recruitment for the training if it is revealed that you are not eligible for the training as you have got registered/ or was following a fulltime programme as mentioned in 6.1, 6.2 or 6.3 above or if you are not eligible under 6.4 or 6.5 conditions you will be withdrawn from the training /dismissed from the post and all the expenses incurred by the government until then will be recovered from you. Further, their names will be included in the blacklisted names for recruiting to government service.
- 7.4. The validity date of all educational and other certificates submitted for verification of eligibility should be on or before 31.08.2026 which is the last date of submission of applications.
- 7.5. Also, after applying for a certain course without the qualifications specified in the *Gazette* notification, this ministry will not bear any responsibility for the inconvenience caused to the applicant.

8. The method of application:

- 8.1. Candidates shall apply for the above training courses via the official website of the Ministry of Health and Mass Media (www.health.gov.lk). They are required to fill and submit the online application on the website. To fill out the application, please refer to the **instruction form provided alongside the Gazette notification on our website.**
- 8.2. The application form should be filled in English only.
- 8.3. If you have fulfilled the required qualifications for the above courses, you can apply for one or more courses. Thus, if you are applying for two or more courses, you should select each course in the order of priority according to your preference in the application form shown on the website. After uploading the completed application, you will not be allowed to change the order of the courses selected and marked in it according to your preference or withdraw one or more of the selected courses or add a new course or more under any circumstances.
- 8.4. 9. The attestation of the applicant's signature:

- 9.1. The signature of the applicant should be attested by an officer in Sri Lanka Administrative Service / an officer in Sri Lanka Educational Administrative Service / an officer in Sri Lanka Accountants' Service / a Government Principal / a Justice of the Peace / An attorney of Law or an officer who hold a permanent and pensionable post and draws an annual salary not less than Rs. 8,54,840/=
- 9.2. The applications that are not complying with the above terms of the *Gazette* or incomplete applications will be rejected without any notice.

10. If you are called for the interview, you shall submit the following documents:

- 10.1. Out of the applicants those who have satisfied the minimum educational qualifications, according to the successfully uploaded online application, only a selected number of applicants will be called for the interview based on a priority list prepared according to the Z score. A general interview will be held by a board of interview appointed by the Secretary of the Ministry of Health and Mass Media. - 10.11. A solemn declaration of the candidate. (Self-declared certificate to prove that one is free of disqualifications as per sub-paragraphs 6.1 to 6.4 of paragraph 6)

Note:

- (a) The documents mentioned **from 10.2 to 10.11** above true copies of the originals certified by the applicant himself/herself should be brought to the interview.
- (b) After considering the available vacancies in training schools, service requirements and facts mentioned in section 4.2., the number to be recruited for training and the number of applicants to be called for interview will be determined by the Secretary of the Ministry of Health and Mass Media.
- (c) Any section herein does not mean that those who are called for the interview are selected and it should not be understood so.
- (d) After conducting the interview, the information about the selected applicants will be **published on the website of this Ministry <http://www.health.gov.lk> and no one will be notified personally**. However, if it is necessary to inform about specific information that arises from time to time, they will be done through the phone number and email address that you have submitted with the application. 11. Scheme of training:

- 11.1. Applicants selected from the interview will be admitted to training schools to follow the training course. Period of the course and the medium in which the course should be followed mentioned in table 01.
- 11.2. Trainees who are admitted to the training schools will be subject to the rules and regulations which are effective in the training schools and the orders imposed by the Ministry of Health and Mass Media from time to time.
- 11.3. Training of those who fail the prescribed examinations, whose work and conduct are not satisfactory of who fail to adhere to relevant conditions of examination and conditions of leave of the training school or whose educational and other qualifications are found to be false, may be terminated at any time without any compensation.
- 11.4. A monthly allowance will be paid to the trainees during the training in terms of the provisions of section VI of Public Administration circular 10/2025.
- 11.5. At the time of admission to the training school, the trainee shall undertake to complete the training successfully and not withdraw from or abandon the course. Upon successful completion of the training, if appointed to the relevant post, the trainee shall serve for a minimum period of ten (10) years under the Government or Provincial Public Service in the relevant position. The trainee shall also enter into an agreement with an officer nominated by the Secretary of the Ministry of Health and Mass Media and execute a bond, supported by two acceptable sureties, in respect of the training and the compulsory period of service, as required by the Ministry of Health

and Mass Media. According to 11.3 above, students who withdraw from training during the training period, leave training, have to be removed from training or fail to serve in the relevant position for a period of ten (10) years after being appointed will be removed from training / position and paid to them by the government during the relevant period. Allowances, fees incurred and contracted amounts shall be paid to the Ministry of Health & Mass Media. If not, steps will be taken to recover the money according to the agreement and legally.

- 11.6. Applicants applying for School Dental Therapy training must be unmarried/not divorced by the commencing date of the application process, and it is mandatory to remain unmarried during the training period.

12. Terms of Employment:

- 12.1. Government is not bound to grant permanent appointments at the end of the training. However, the candidates will be considered for appointing to a post in Class III of the post concerned on the basis of the merit obtained at the final examination of the training to fill the vacancies remaining after making the transfers of senior officers, according to the priority list of vacancies prepared based on the vacancies exist as at the date of completion of the training. Further selected applicants should serve in any part of the Sri Lanka, based on existing vacancies.
- 12.2. If permanent appointment is granted at the end of the training period, salaries will be paid in terms of the provisions of the Public Administration Circular No. 10/2025
- 12.3. Applicants should carefully and accurately fill the particulars of education and other qualifications in the application. If the above certificates are proved to be false after recruitment to the training or after appointment, action will be taken to refer the case to the Criminal Investigation Department for taking legal action / to cancel the appointment, to dismiss him/her from the training / post, and to enter his / her name in to the black list of those who are not permitted to be reemployed in the Public Service after taking disciplinary action against him / her. Action will be taken to recover the allowance paid to him / her during the training period, expenses incurred by the Government, and the amount of the Agreement and Surety Bond.
- 12.4. Selected applicants should submit themselves for a medical examination during the first month of the training to certify that the applicant is physically and mentally fit to follow the course and to serve in any part of the Island and if an applicant is found to be unfit from the medical examination, he / she will be disqualified from the training.
- 12.5. All persons selected as above will be subjected to provisions of the Establishment Code of Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka rules, regulations and orders imposed by the Public Service Commission regarding the Public Service, provisions of the service minutes, Financial Regulations, circulars and instructions of the Government and orders imposed and amendments made thereto from time to time.
- 12.6. This Ministry is not bound to provide hostel facilities in the training schools for the applicants recruited for the training. If such facilities provided, rent assessed for a housing room, water and electricity charges will be incurred.
- 12.7. During the period of training, trainees shall not have the right to engage in trade union activities or undertake any private employment.
- 12.8. If any issue or dispute arises regarding any matter relating to the recruitment for the training programme, whether or not specifically provided for in this *Gazette Notification*, the decision of the Secretary to the Ministry of Health and Mass Media shall be final. In the event of any inconsistency or discrepancy among the Sinhala, Tamil, and English versions of this *Gazette Notification*, the Sinhala version shall prevail.

It is hereby notified that the notification titled Open Competitive Examination for Recruitment to Grade III in the Executive Service Category (Post of Statistician) of the Department of Census and Statistics - 2026 in the Gazette of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka No. 2497 dated 10.07.2026 is hereby amended by substituting the following paragraphs for Sub Paragraph IV of Paragraph No. 02 and the Educational Qualifications set out under Paragraph No 03 and Sub Paragraphs III and IV of Paragraph No. 08 of the English Version of the said notification.

I. Paragraph No IV under Number 2 of the notification is amended as follows.

The first efficiency bar examination should be passed within 03 years of being appointed to Grade III in the Executive Service Category.

II. Paragraph No. 3 of the notification: Educational qualifications are amended as follows.

Educational Qualifications

- (a) A Special Degree with a Class, in which at least one of the following subjects has

been offered as a major subject: Statistics, Mathematics, Economics, Demography, Population Studies, Computer Science, Information Technology, Geography, Sociology, or Cartography, obtained from:

- a). a foreign or state university recognized by the University Grants Commission;
or

- b). a university established by an Act of Parliament in Sri Lanka; or

- c). a degree-awarding institute recognized under Section 25A of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978.

or

- (b) A General Degree with First Class or Second Class (Upper Division) Honors, in which at least one of the following subjects has been offered as a major subject: Statistics, Mathematics, Economics, Demography, Population Studies, Computer Science, Information Technology, Geography, Sociology, or Cartography, obtained from:

- a) a foreign or state university recognized by the University Grants Commission;
or

- b) a university established by an Act of Parliament in Sri Lanka; or

- c) a degree-awarding institute recognized under Section 25A of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978.

Note :

- i. In cases where the specific subject area is not clearly stated in a special degree certificate, the subject area that has a value equal to or greater than 2/3 of the total credit points to be earned during the period of study in the specific field shall be considered as the main subject of that special degree course.
- ii. A subject that carries a value equal to or greater than 1/3 of the total credit value of the relevant subjects for an ordinary degree is considered a major subject of that degree.

III. Paragraph No. III under Number 8 of the notification is amended as follows.

The online application shall be completed in the English language only. Upon receipt by the Department of Examinations the electronic copy of the application submitted online by the applicant, the Department shall notify the applicant, by Short Message Service (SMS) to the mobile telephone number used to access the system or by e-mail to the e-mail address provided, whether the electronic application has been accepted as a valid application or not.

Before completing the online application, applicants shall download the Instructions prepared for submitting the application for the examination. The instructions shall be strictly followed when completing the application.

Any amendment made after obtaining a printed copy of the application shall not be regarded as a valid amendment. Incomplete applications shall be rejected without notice.

IV. Paragraph No. IV under Number 8 of the notification is amended as follows.

The issuance of an examination admission card to a candidate shall not be construed as an acknowledgment that he/she has met the qualifications to sit for the examination or to be considered eligible for appointment to the post. Furthermore, if the requirements of paragraphs (i) / (ii) of paragraph 3 of this notification are not met, a candidate will not be eligible for appointment to this post even if he obtains the passing marks specified in sub-paragraph 7.1.2 of the notification.

Penalties for false information:- While filling the application form, one should be very careful and provide accurate information. If any candidate is found to be ineligible as per the rules and regulations of this examination, his/her candidature may be cancelled at any time before, during or after the examination.
