An ACT TO INCORPORATE THE RAHULA COLLEGE MATARA PAST STUDENTS ASSOCIATION (COLOMBO BRANCH)

WHEREAS an association called and known as Rahula Preamble. College Matara Past Students Association (Colombo Branch) has heretofore been formed in Colombo for the purpose of effectually carrying out and transacting all objects and matters connected with the said association according to the rules agreed to by its members:

AND WHEREAS the said Association has heretofore successfully carried out and transacted the serveral objects and matters for which it was formed and has applied to be 10 incorporated and it will be for the public advantage to grant such application:

BE it therefore enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows :-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Rahula College Matara Short title. 15 Past Students Association (Colombo Branch) (Incorporation) Act, No. of 2010.
- 2. From and after the date of commencement of this Act, Incorporation such and so many persons as now are members of the Rahula of the Rahula College Matara Past Students Association (Colombo Branch) College Past 20 (hereinafter referred to as the "Association") or shall hereafter be admitted members of the Corporation hereby constituted

and be sued in all courts with full power and authority to have and use a common seal and to alter the same at its

> objects of the Corporation.

(a) To promote educational, cultural and social activities among past pupils, present pupils, present teachers and former teachers of Rahula College;

- (b) To preserve the natural resources and create infrastructure facilities and develop and maintain same for the well being of the students of Rahula College;
- 5 (c) To promote Welfare, Cultural and Social Development activities among students and teachers so as to improve cordial relationship between the two groups;
- (d) To establish the Rahula Scholarships Trust for award 10 of scholarships prizes and other grants;
 - (e) To establish libraries, research and training centers and maintain same;
 - (f) For the purpose of Vocational training to students maintain cordial relationships with foreign and local non governmental organizations;

- (g) To commence projects which generate income to be used for the activities of the Corporation;
- 4. Subject to the provisions of this Act and any other General written Law, the Corporation shall have the power to do, powers of the 20 perform and execute, all such acts, matters and things whatsoever as are necessary or desirable for the promotion, or furtherance of the objects of the Corporation or any one of them, including the power to open, operate and close a bank accounts, to borrow or raise moneys, with or without security, 25 to receive or collect grants and donations, to invest its funds and to engage, employ and dismiss officers and servants required for the carrying out of the objects of the Corporation:

5. (1) The affairs of the Corporation shall, subject to the Management rules in force for the time being of the Corporation, be of the affairs 30 administered by an Executive Committee elected in Corporation. accordance with the rules of the Corporation.

- (2) The First Executive Committee of the Corporation shall be the Members of the Board of Management of the Association holding office on the day preceding the date of the commencement of this act.
- **6.** The Corporation shall be able and capable in law to Corporation take over, acquire and hold and property, movable or immovable, which may become vested in it by virtue of any purchase, grant, gift, testamentary desposition or otherwise, immovable. and all such property shall be held by the Corporation for the 10 purpose of this Act and subject to the rules of the Corporation, it shall have power to sell, mortgage, lease, exchange or otherwise dispose of the same.

7. (1) It shall be lawful for the Corporation, from time Rules of the to time, at any general meeting and by a majority of not less Corporation. 15 than two-thirds of the members present and voting, to make rules, not inconsistent with the provisions of this act or any other written law, for all or any of the following matters:—

(a) classification of membership, fees payable by such class of members and their admission, withdrawal or expulsion or resignation;

- (b) the election of members of the Executive Committee and the office-bearers, resignation or removal from, or vacation of, office of members of the Executive Commitee, powers, duties and conduct of the members of the Executive Committee, the appointment, powers, duties, functions and conduct of the various officers, agents and servants of the Corporation;
- (c) the procedure to be observed at, and the summoning 30 and holding of meetings of the Executive Committee and the Corporation, filling vacancies, notices and agenda of such meetings the quorum therefore and the conduct of business thereat:

- (d) the qualifications and disqualifications for membership in the Executive Committee and the Corporation;
- (e) the administration and management of the property 5 of the Corporation; and
 - (f) Generally for the management of the affairs of the Corporation and the accomplishment of its objects and the dissolution of the Corporation.
- (2) Any rule made by the Corporation may be amended, 10 altered, or rescinded at a like metting and in a like manner as a rule made under subsection (1).
 - (3) The members of the Corporation shall be subject to the rules of the Corporation.
- 8. (1) The Corporation shall have its own fund and all Fund of the 15 moneys received by way of testamentary dispositions, Corporation. transfers, donations, contributions or fees shall be deposited to the credit of the Corporation in one or more Banks as the Executive Committee shall determine.

- (2) There shall be paid out of the fund all sums of money 20 required to defray any expenditure incurred by the Corporation in the exercise, performance and discharge of its powers, duties and functions under this act.
- (3) The moneys of the Corporation shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objects as setforth herein and 25 no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or otherwise howsoever to the members of the Corporation.
 - **9.** (a) The financial year of the Corporation shall be the Audit and calendar year.

Accounts of Corporation.

30 (b) The Executive Committee of the Corporation shall cause to be kept proper books of account with respect to all sums of money received and expended by the Corporation.

(c) The accounts of the Corporation shall be audited by a qualified auditor.

In this section, "qualified auditor" means —

- (i) an individual who being a member of the institute 5 of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka, or of any other institute established by law, possesses a certificate to practice as an Accountant issued by the Council of such institute: or
- a firm of Accountants each of the resident partners 10 of which, being a member of the institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka or of any other institute established by law, possesses a certificate to practice as an Accountant issued by the Council of such institute:
- The seal of the Corporation shall not be affixed to Seal of the 15 any instrument except in the presence of the President and either the Secretary or Treasurer who shall sign their names to the instrument in token of their presence and such signing shall be independent of the signing of any person as a witness.

All debts and liabilities of the Association existing Debts due by on the day preceding the date of commencement of this Act and payable shall be paid by the Corporation hereby constituted and all debts due to and subscriptions and contributions payable to the Association on that day shall be paid to the Association 25 for the purposes of this Act.

12. No member of the Corporation shall, for the purpose Limitation of of discharging the debts and liabilities of the Corporation, or liability of for any other purpose, be liable to make any contribution Members. exceeding the amount of such membership fees as may be

14. No person shall be liable in any suit or other legal Indemnity proceeding for any act done, or purporting to be done, in for Acts done good faith in pursuance of the powers conferred by or under this Act, or for the purpose of carrying out of provisions of 5 this Act.
