## Madahapola Sri Ratnapalaramaya Religious and Buddhist Educational Development Foundation(Incorporation)

An Act to incorporate the Madahapola Sri Ratnapalaramaya RELIGIOUS AND BUDDHIST EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT FOUNDATION

WHEREAS a society called and known as the "Madahapola Preamble. Sri Ratnapalaramaya Religious and Buddhist Educational Development Foundation", has heretofore been formed at Madahapola for the purpose of effectually carrying out its 5 objects and transacting all matters connected with the said foundation according to the rules agreed to by the members.

AND WHEREAS the said society has heretofore successfully carried out and transacted the several objects and matters for which it was formed and has applied to be incorporated and 10 as acceding to this request will be for the public interest.

BE it therefore enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Madahapola Sri Short title. Ratnapalaramaya Religious and Buddhist Educational 15 Development Foundation (Incorporation) Act, No. of 2011.

2. From and after the commencement of this Act, such Incorporation and so many persons as now are members of the Madahapola of Sri Ratnapalaramaya Religious and Buddhist Educational Sri Foundation (hereinafter referred to as "the Foundation") and Ratnapalaramaya 20 such other persons as shall hereafter be admitted as members Religious and of the corporation hereby constituted, shall be, and become Educational a body corporate with perpetual succession under the name Foundation. and style of the "Madahapola Sri Ratnapalaramaya Religious and Buddhist Educational Development 25 Foundation" (hereinafter referred to as "The Corporation") and by that name may sue and be sued in all courts with full power and authority to have and use a common seal, and alter the same at its pleasure.

## 2 Madahapola Sri Ratnapalaramaya Religious and Buddhist Educational Development Foundation(Incorporation)

- 3. The general objects for which Corporation is General constituted are hereby declared to be:
  - objects of the Corporation.
- (a) protect and nourish Buddhism, safeguard the rights of Buddhists, Protect the spiritual, educational, cultural and social rights of Buddhists;

- (b) bring about moral and economic progress of the society through quantitative and qualitative development of Buddhist Bhikkus in historical Yapahuwa area;
- 10 (c) draw advisory and financial support from Centers of Bhikku Organizations, Government Institutions, Non-Governmental Organizations, Sasana Development Fund of the Dalada Maligawa, the Sri Siddartha Saranankara Welfare Foundation 15 of Malwathu Viharaya and foreign embassies;
  - (d) lay the foundation for a long term program for religious development by establishing a fund and incorporating it;
- (e) construct a building complex with residential 20 facilities for about 100 Bhikkus, endowed with capabilities for the development of religious activities, modern communication skills and proficiency in languages;
- (f) drawing the attention of relevant authorities to the 25 need to pave the way for a life style based on righteous employment in a hydraulic civilization;
  - (g) provide facilities for the temples to serve the public based on the concept 'from temple to the people rather than from people to the temple';
- 30 (h) take necessary steps to lead the youth on righteous paths by moving them away from misdirected paths;

- (i) take action to eradicate the addiction to drugs which is a social menace;
- (j) motivate the people to commence pre-schools in temple premises and implement programs to motivate children to lead a religious life;

- (k) take necessary steps to commence Damma Schools in temples where Damma Schools are not conducted;
- 4. Subject to provisions of this Act and any other written Management 10 law the corporation shall have the power to do, perform and of the execute all such acts, matters and things whatsoever, as are necessary or desirable for the promotion or furtherance of Corporation. the objects of the Corporation or any one of them, including power to open, operate and close bank accounts, borrow or 15 raise moneys with or without security, to accept and or collect grants and donations, to invest the corporations funds and to engage, employ and dismiss officers and servants required or suitable for promotion and carrying out all of or any one of the objects of the Corporation.

5. The affairs of the corporation shall be managed by a Rules of the Board of Management selected subject to and in accordance Corporation. with the regulations of the Board.

rules as are not inconsistent with the provisions of this Act or any other written law for the purpose of admission, resignation and expulsion of members, procedure to be observed in the transaction of the business of the Corporation and general administration or in pursuit of the objects of Corporation by the representatives, employees or the Directorate.

Rules so made can be amended or rescinded in the same manner they were made at a similar meeting.

10 8. The members of the corporation shall be subjected to Members of the rules of the Corporation.

9. The corporation shall be able and capable in law to Corporation acquire and hold any property, movable or immovable, which may become vested in by virtue of any purchase, grant, gift 15 and testamentary disposition or otherwise and all such property shall be held by the Corporation for the purpose of the Corporation and subject to rules of this Act and provisions of the Corporation with full power to mortgage, sell, lease, exchange or otherwise dispose of the same.

20 10. All debts and liabilities of the foundation existing Debts on the day preceding the day of commencement of the Act payable by shall be paid by the Corporation hereby constituted and all and payable debts due to and subscriptions and contributions payable to Corporation. the Corporations on that day, shall be paid to the Corporation 25 for the purpose of this Act.

11. The Seal of the Corporation shall not be affixed to Seal of the any instrument whatsoever except in the presence of two Corporation. member of the Board of Management who shall sign their names to the instrument in token of their presence, and such

30 signing shall be independent of the signing of any person as a witness.

- 12. (1) The Corporation shall cause proper accounts to be Audit and kept of its income and expenditure, assets and liabilities accounts. and all other transactions of the Corporation.
- (2) The accounts of the Corporation shall be audited by a 5 qualified Auditor.
  - (3) In this section, "qualified Auditor" means—
- an individual who being a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka, or of any other institute established by law, possesses a 10 certificate to practice as an Accountant issued by the Council of such institute; or
  - (b) a firm of Accountants each of the resident partners of which, being a member of the Institute of Chartered Accountants of Sri Lanka or of any other institute established by law, possesses a certificate to practice as an Accountant issued by the Council of such Institute.

- 13. If upon dissolution of the Corporation, there remains Property any property whatsoever, after the satisfaction of all debts remaining on and liabilities, such property shall not be distributed among dissolution. the members of the Corporation, but shall be given or transferred to some other institution having objects similar to those of the Corporation, and which is or are by its rules prohibited from distributing any income or property among 25 its or their members. Such institution or institutions may be determined by the members of the Committee of Management on or before the dissolution of the Corporation.
- 14. Nothing contained in this Act shall prejudice the Savings of rights of the Republic or any body politic or corporate or the rights of any other person except the rights of those mentioned in the Republic this Act and those claiming rights from them or through them or under them.

15. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala text Sinhala and Tamil texts of this Act, the Sinhala text shall to prevail in 35 prevail.
