#### STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

Clause 2 : This clause amends section 5 of the Commercial Mediation Centre of Sri Lanka Act, No. 44 of 2000 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal enactment"), and the legal effect of the section as amended is to increase the number of members of the Board of Management of the Commercial Mediation Centre with a view to ensuring better co-ordination among the line agencies.

*Clause 3*: This clause amends section 6 of the principal enactment and the legal effect of the section as amended is to enable the Minister to appoint the Chairman of the Board of Management and to specify the manner by which the Chairman can be removed from office.

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:-

(2) In subsection (7) thereof, by the substitution for the words and figures "paragraphs (a), (b), (c), or (d) of subsection (1)" of the words and figures "subparagraphs (a), (b), (c), or (d) of paragraph (ii) of subsection (1)".

**3.** Section 6 of the principal enactment is hereby Amendment of section 6 amended as follows:-
