STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

Clause 2: This clause amends subsection (1) of section 6 of the Chemical Weapons Convention Act, No. 58 of 2007 and the legal effect of that section as amended is to change the portfolio of the Minister who shall be charged with the implementation of this Act.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE CHEMICAL WEAPONS CONVENTION ACT, No. 58 of 2007.

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:—

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Chemical Weapons Short title. Convention (Amendment) Act, No. of 2018.
- 2. Section 6 of the Chemical Weapons Convention Act, Amendment No. 58 of 2007 is hereby amended in subsection (1) thereof of section 6 by the substitution for the words "Minister in charge of the $$N_{\rm O}.58$\,{\rm of}$$ subject of Industries" of the words "Minister assigned the 2007. subject of Defence".
