STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

Clause 2: This clause amends section 75 of the Penal Code (Chapter 19) (hereinafter referred to as the "principal enactment") and the legal effect of the section as amended is to increase the age limit under which no act of a child is an offence.

Clause 3: This clause amends section 76 of the principal enactment and the legal effect of the section as amended is to raise the age segment within which no act of a child is an offence, if the judge is of the opinion that he has not attained sufficient maturity to understand the nature and consequences of his act.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE PENAL CODE (CHAPTER 19)

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist

1. This Act may be cited as the Penal Code Short title. (Amendment) Act, No. of 2018.

- 5 2. Section 75 of the Penal Code (Chapter 19) (hereinafter Amendment referred to as the "principal enactment") is hereby amended of section 75 of by the substitution— Chapter 19.
