#### STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

*Clause 2:* This clause amends section 4 of the Prescription (Special Provisions) Act, No. 5 of 2016 in order to extend the time period within which a disadvantaged person is entitled to avail himself of the benefits of the Act.

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows:—

**1.** This Act may be cited as the Prescription (Special Short title. Provisions) (Amendment) Act, No. of 2018.

5 2. Section 4 of the Prescription (Special Provisions) Act, Amendment of section 4 No. 5 of 2016 is hereby amended as follows: of Act, No. 5 of 2016. (1) by the substitution for the words "two years after the coming into operation of this Act." of the words "four years from the date of coming into operation 10 of this Act."; (2) by the substitution for the words "two years after the date of operation of this Act.", in the marginal note to that section, of the words "four years from the date of coming into operation of this Act.". 15 3. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala Sinhala text and Tamil texts of this Act, the Sinhala text shall prevail. to prevail in case of

inconsistency.
