STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

Clauses 2: This clause amends the long title of the Mahapola Higher Education Scholarship Trust Fund Act, No. 66 of 1981 (hereinafter referred to as the "principal enactment" and the legal effect of the amendment is to replace the words "MAHAPOLA HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP TRUST FUND ACT" with the words "LALITH ATHULATHMUDALI MAHAPOLA HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP TRUST FUND ACT".

Clauses 3: This clause amends principal enactment and other written laws and the legal effect of the amendment is to replace the words –

- (a) "Mahapola Higher Education Scholarship Trust Fund Act" with the words "Lalith Athulathmudali Mahapola Higher Education Scholarship Trust Fund Act";
- (b) "Mahapola Higher Education Scholarship Trust Fund" with the words "Lalith Athulathmudali Mahapola Higher Education Scholarship Trust Fund".

Clause 4: This clause amends section 3 of the principal enactment and the legal effect of the section as amended is to change the composition of the Board of Trustees of the Fund and make provision to appoint a retired judge of the Supreme Court as the Chairman of the Board.

Clause 5: This clause amends section 15 of the principal enactment and the legal effect of the section as amended is to extend the application of that section to the Trustees of the Fund.

Clause 6: This clause inserts a new section 15A in the principal enactment and the legal effect of the section as amended is to make the provisions of the Offences Against Public Property Act, No. 12 of 1982 applicable to the properties of the Fund.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE MAHAPOLA HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP Trust Fund Act, No. 66 of 1981

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka as follows: -

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Mahapola Higher Education Short title Scholarship Trust Fund (Amendment) Act, No.
- 5 2. The long title of the Mahapola Higher Education Amendment Scholarship Trust Fund Act, No. 66 of 1981 (hereinafter of the long referred to as the "principal enactment") is hereby amended title to Act, No.66 of by the substitution for the words "MAHAPOLA HIGHER 1981 EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP TRUST FUND", of the words, 10 "LALITH ATHULATHMUDALI MAHAPOLA HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP TRUST FUND".
 - 3. (1) In the principal enactment and in any other written General law, there shall be substituted -

wherever such words appear in the principal enactment and other written law.

(2) Every reference to the "Mahapola Higher Education 25 Scholarship Trust Fund Act" and "Mahapola Higher Education Scholarship Trust Fund" in any notice, notification, contract, communication, agreement, form or

other document shall be read and construed as a reference to the "Lalith Athulathmudali Mahapola Higher Education Scholarship Trust Fund Act" and "Lalith Athulathmudali Mahapola Higher Education Scholarship Trust Fund".

Section 3 of the principal enactment is hereby amended Amendment as follows:-

Amendment of section 3 of the principal

- (1) by the repeal of subsection (2) thereof and the principal enactment substitution therefor of the following subsection:-
- "(2) The Board of Trustees of the Fund (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") shall consist of the following members:-
 - (a) the founder;
 - (b) a retired Judge of the Supreme Court appointed by the President for a period of three years who shall be the Chairman of the Board;
 - (c) the persons for the time being holding office as—
 - (i) the Secretary to the Ministry of the Minister to whom the subject of Higher Education is assigned;
 - (ii) the Secretary to the Ministry of the Minister to whom the subject of Education is assigned;
 - (iii) the Secretary to the Ministry of the Minister to whom the subject of Trade is assigned; and
 - (d) two persons appointed by the founder (hereinafter referred to as the "appointed members") for a period of five years."; and

6. The following new section is hereby inserted Insertion of immediately after section 15 of the principal enactment and new section shall have effect as section 15A of that enactment: -

15A in the principal enactment

"Provisions 10 of Offences Against Public Property Act, No. 12 of 1982 to apply

15A. All movable and immovable property of the Fund shall be deemed to be public property within the meaning of, and for the purposes of, the Offences Against Public Property Act, No. 12 of 1982.".

7. For the avoidance of doubt, it is hereby declared that Avoidance of 15 the "Lalith Athulathmudali Mahapola Higher Education doubt Scholarship Trust Fund", shall, for all purposes be deemed to be the successor to the "Mahapola Higher Education Scholarship Trust Fund".

8. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala Sinhala text 20 and Tamil texts of this Act, the Sinhala text shall prevail.
