STATEMENT OF LEGAL EFFECT

Clause 2 : This clause amends section 10 of the principal enactment and the legal effect of the section as amended is to employ before 6.00 a.m or after 6.00 p.m any female employee who has attained the age of eighteen in any institution which is engaged in business, based on information technology and knowledge process outsourcing or business process outsourcing or engaged in administration of accounts or related work in a Back Office for an institute situated abroad.

Clause 3 : This clause amends section 66 of the principal enactment to enable the Minister to make regulations specifying the terms and conditions relating to welfare of such females including their security, transport facilities and facilities to rest to be followed by an employer who employs such female after 10.00 p.m. and before 6.00 a.m.

Clause 4 : This clause amends section 68 of the principal enactment to expand the definition of the expression “office” and is consequential to the amendment made to Clause 2.

AN ACT TO AMEND THE SHOP AND OFFICE EMPLOYEES
(REGULATION OF EMPLOYMENT AND REMUNERATION) ACT
(CHAPTER 129)

BE it enacted by the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist
Republic of Sri Lanka as follows: -

1. This Act may be cited as the Shop and Office Short title
Employees (Regulation of Employment and Remuneration)
5 (Amendment) Act, No. of 2023.

2. Section 10 of the Shop and Office Employees Amendment
(Regulation of Employment and Remuneration) Act (Chapter of section 10
129) (in this Act referred to as the “principal enactment”) is of Chapter 129
hereby amended as follows: -

10 (1) in subparagraph (iii) of paragraph (b) of subsection
(2), by the substitution for the words and figures
“between 6.00 p.m. and 8.00 p.m.; and” of the
words and figures “between 6.00 p.m. and 8.00
p.m.”;

15 (2) in subparagraph (iv) of paragraph (b) of subsection
(2), by the substitution for the words and figures
“between 6.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m.” of the words
and figures “between 6.00 p.m. and 10.00 p.m.;
and”;

20 (3) by the insertion, immediately after subparagraph
(iv) of paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of the
following: -

25 “(v) any female who has attained the age
of eighteen years may be employed
in any institution which is engaged in
business, based on information technology
and knowledge process outsourcing or
business process outsourcing, or engaged
in administration and accounts or related

abroad before 6.00 a.m. or after 6.00 p.m. on
any day.”.

5 3. Section 66 of the principal enactment is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after paragraph (f) of subsection (2), of the following: - Amendment of
section 66 of
the principal
enactment

10 “(fa) in respect of the terms and conditions to be followed by an employer who employs any female, relating to the welfare of such females, including their security, transport facilities and facilities to rest when such females are employed after 10.00 p.m. and before 6.00 a.m.;”.

4. Section 68 of the principal enactment is hereby amended as follows: - Amendment of
section 68 of

15 (1) in paragraph (a), in the definition of the expression “office”, by the substitution for the words “literature), and” of the words “literature);”;

20 (2) in paragraph (b) thereof, by the substitution for the words “for the purposes of this Act;” of the words “for the purposes of this Act; and”;

(3) by the addition, immediately after paragraph (b) thereof, of the following: -

25 “(c) any institution engaged in business, based on information technology and knowledge process outsourcing or business process outsourcing or engaged in administration and accounts or related work in a back office in connection with
30 any institution situated abroad;”.
