TAKING OVER BASE HOSPITAL - MAHIYANGANAYA BY THE LINE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND MASS MEDIA FOR DEVELOPMENT AND UPGRADING

THE Type “A” Base Hospital in Mahiyanganaya is a key secondary healthcare institution located in the Badulla District of Uva Province and is currently administered by the Uva Provincial Council. In light of the ongoing development challenges faced by the hospital, particularly the extensive damage caused by heavy rainfall and Cyclone Ditwa, It has been proposed that the hospital be brought under the administration of the Line Ministry of Health and Mass Media.

This is to inform that, in accordance with Cabinet Decision No. CP/26/0510/815/033 dated 23rd March 2026, and with the concurrence of the Governor of the Uva Province, Base Hospital - Mahiyanganaya will be taken over by the Line Ministry of Health and Mass Media for the purposes of development and upgrading.

The Cabinet of Ministers has granted approval to take over Base Hospital - Mahiyanganaya, including all physical and financial assets, under the Line Ministry of Health and Mass Media. Approval has also been granted for the absorption of staff members currently serving at the hospital who wish to join the Line Ministry, based on their preference and subject to the conditions to be stipulated by the Public Service Commission.

Upon completion of the takeover process, plans will be made for the future development and upgrading of the hospital facilities.
