Regulations

01. By the repeal of fifth schedule which indicated in the Explosive Regulations 1979, published through the *Extraordinary Gazette* No. 23/5 of 13.02.1999 which was amended by the *Extraordinary Gazette* No. 1133/13 of 24th May 2000 and substitution therefore of the following new Schedule.

Fees for the Licenses and Permits

01	License to carry on the business of a manufacturer of explosives	
	(a) Only for manufacturing the blasting powder	Rs. 2,000.00
	(b) Only for manufacturing the safety fuses	Rs. 4,000.00
	(c) For manufacturing both the blasting powder and the safety fuses	Rs. 7,000.00
	(d) Other explosives	
	I. For the quantities do not exceed 12,000 Kg	Rs. 1,000.00
	II. For the quantities do not exceed 60,000 Kg	Rs. 2,000.00
	III. For the quantities which exceed 60,000 Kg	Rs. 5,000.00

02. Equivalent circle to determine the quantities of explosives which are not being indicated according to the weith.
- (a) 500m of safety fuses should be concerned as an one kilogram
 - (b) 500 detonators should be concerned as an one kilogram
 - (c) 500 meters of detonator code should be concerned as an one kilogram
 - (d) 250 ammunitions should be concerned as an one kilogram

03. Amended regulations mentioned in above should be implemented with effect from 01st October 2016.
