STATUTORY DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 19 OF LAND REFORM LAW No. 1 OF 1972

SINCE, Mrs. Shyamini Tennakoon Adhihetty Gunarathna, the daughter of late Asanka Anoma Wijewardena Tennakoon Adhihetty, at official Quarters of Gampola district judge, has made a late statutory declaration under Section 18 of the Law with regard to the legacy of Asanka Anoma Wijewardena Tennakoon Adhihetty, when Land Reform Law came into effect, she and her brothers and sisters were minors and her father was alive, the Land Reform Commission, as per the powers vested in it under Section 19 of the Law, the said Commission has affected a part of statutory determination on Walter Dayaratne Adhihetty's legacy. As he demised, specifying the portion of Agricultural Land owned by Walter Dayaratne Adhihetty who is statutory lessee, which shall be allowed to retain, the agricultural land so allowed to be retained by the statutory lessee is described in the Schedule below.
