SERVICE MINUTE OF THE MANAGEMENT SERVICE OFFICERS' SERVICE - REVISION No. 04

THE Public Service Commission has ordered to include the revision mentioned here as revision No.04 in substitution for the revision published in *Gazette Extraordinary* of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka No. 2383/06 dated 06 May 2024 as revision No.04 of the Minute of the Management Service Officers' Service published in *Gazette Extraordinary* of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka No.1840/34 dated 11 December 2013, revised by *Gazettes Extraordinary* of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka in the following manner.

Revision No. 01 - *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2032/26 dated 16 August 2017 Revision No. 02 - *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2052/26 dated 04 January 2018 Revision No. 03 - *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2140/04 dated 09 September 2019 Revision No. 04 - *Gazette Extraordinary* No. 2383/06 dated 06 May 2024*

Paragraph 1.7 Should be revised in the following manner.

7.2.2.1 Educational Qualifications

(a) Shall have passed the G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination in six (06) subjects in one sitting with credit passes for 04 subjects, including Language (Sinhala / Tamil / English) and Mathematics or passed in one sitting an Examination recognized by the Commissioner General of Examination as equivalent to the G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) examination with the passes and credits to the subject in a similar combination.

(The medium of Language in which the applicant sits the competitive examination for recruitment to the Management Service Officers' Service shall be considered as the Language for which a credit pass shall have been obtained at the G.C.E (Ordinary Level) examination.)

and

(b) Shall have passed the G.C.E. (Advanced Level) examination in all subjects (except for the Common General Test) in one sitting (It is sufficient to have passed three subjects in one sitting under the old syllabus) or passed in one sitting an examination recognized by the Commissioner General of Examination as equivalent to the G.C.E. (Advanced Level) examination with the passes and credits to the subjects in a similar combination.
