PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION IN THE NORTH WESTERN PROVINCE

Open Competitive Examination for the Recruitment to the Post of Instructor/Instructress in Textiles (Grade III) of the Department of Textiles in the North Western Provincial Public Service - 2010

APPLICATIONS are invited from the male and female permanent residents within the North Western Province who have satisfied the qualifications referred to in this notification, for the post of Instructor/Instructress in Textiles (Grade III) in the Department of Textiles of the North Western Provincial Public Service.

01. *Number of vacancies.* – 20.

02. *Salary scale :*

2.1 As per the Public Administration Circular No. 06/2006(iv) the monthly salary scale applicable to this post is Rs. 13,120 - 10 x 145 - 11 x 170 - 10x 320 - Rs. 22,040 according to MN 1/2006A.

Note. – This salary scale will be subject to amendments made from time to time by the government. The officers recruited to this post should pass the Efficiency Bar Examination before reaching the monthly salary step Rs. 13,555.

2.2 *Age Limit.* – The age should not be less than 18 years and not more than 45 years on the last date for acceptance of applications. The maximum age limit will not be applicable for the candidates those who are already employed in the Public/Provincial Public Service on permanent basis. They should submit their application through their Heads of Department.

2.3 *Conditions of Employment.* – Conditions of Employment will be determined in terms of the approved recruitment and promotion procedure. This post is permanent and pensionable. Selected candidates should contribute for the widows/widowers and orphans' pension scheme from the date of appointment.

03. *Education and other qualifications :* –

3.1 Should have passed 06 subjects at the G. C. E. (O/L) Examination in not more than two sittings with credits for 03 subjects including Sinhala/Tamil and Mathematics.

3.2 *Professional qualifications.* – Should have passed the three year or two year certificate examination offered by a training institute for textile recognized by the government.

N. B. – Every applicant should have completed and obtained all educational, professional and other qualification aforesaid on the date of 15.02.2011.

04. *Candidates :*

4.1 Should be citizens of Sri Lanka ;

4.2 Should be permanent residents within the area of authority of the North Western Provincial Council during a period not less than 3 years immediately prior to the closing date of applications are accepted. (residency should be proved by electoral register) ;

4.3 If already employed in the public or/Provincial Public Service, he/she should not have been suffered punishment other than warning within the period of immediate 5 years and should have earned all salary increments during the said immediate 5 years.

4.4 Should have an excellent character and physically in good health.

05. *Method of recruitment.* – After calling applications published in the Government *gazette* paper (in the part of Provincial Councils) or by way of public notice as decided by the appointing authority, recruitment will be made to the post of Instructor/Instructress in Textiles (Grade III) on the result of a written examination held by the Public Service commission in the North Western Province or by an institute authorized by it, by holding an interview as decided by the Public Service Commission in the North Western Province to check the qualifications of the candidates who have obtained maximum marks in that examination. 70% of the vacancies in the post of Instructor/Instructress in Textiles (Grade III) will be filled by Open Competitive Examination and 30% will be filled by the limited Competitive Examination, held for the recruitment from Elementary Grades in the Department. If it is unable to fill 30% of the vacancies from the employees of the Department, the balance will be filled on the results of the open competitive examination.

06. *Scheme of Examination :*

A Multiple Choice Question paper for each subject will be prepared. Person who scores 40% marks or above for each question paper will only be qualified for the recruitment.

(ii) Practical test	01 hour	100
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This practical test will be held for the evaluation of fixing machines and on weaving and this will be held before a board consists of 5 officers who have the knowledge in the relevant field.

The interview board will be consisted of the Secretary of the Public Service Commission or a staff officer authorized by him, Provincial Director of Textile in the North Western Province and staff officer of other Department. Education qualifications and other qualifications will be checked there.

07. The Public Service Commission in the NWP reserves the right to take the final decision of filling the vacancies already reported and or which will occur in future from the persons who have been successful at the examination if available.

08. An examination fee of Rs. 250 should be paid to the Divisional Secretariat situated close, so as to be credited to the North Western Provincial Council Fund and the receipt (NWP F2) obtained should be attached to the application. Any receipt or money order other than the receipt obtained by so paying money will not be entertained. The examination fee paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

09. *Method of application :*

9.1 Application forms should be prepared by using both sides of A4 size paper (21x29cm) in accordance with the specimen form of application appended to this notification. Duly filled applications should be sent by registered post to "the Secretary, Public Service Commission, Provincial Council Complex, Kurunegala, to be received before 15.02.2011. The words "recruitment to the post of Instructor/Instructress in Textiles (Grade III) 2010" should be written on the top left hand corner of the envelop enclosing the application. (Candidates those who are already employed in the Public/Provincial Public Service on permanent basis should send their applications through their Head of the Department) Applications received delayed will be rejected without any notice. Receipt of applications will not be acknowledged.

10. The closing date of applications are accepted is 15.02.2011.

11. Applications which do not comply with the qualifications referred to in this notification will be rejected. Issuing of an admission card to a candidate will not be considered as a fulfillment of qualifications to sit for the examination. If it reveals that a candidate has not fulfilled the required qualification at the time of perusal in the interview in terms of this notification, the eligibility to the appointment will be cancelled. Every applicant should have completed every qualification pertaining to each post on or before the closing date of applications are accepted.

12. *Identity of candidates.*— Candidates will be required to prove their identity for each subject they offer in the examination hall to the satisfaction of the supervisor by forwarding any of the following documents :

1. The National Identity Card issued by the Department of Registration of persons,
2. A valid passport.

Note.— Candidates who fail to prove their identity in the examination hall will be considered as ineligible candidates.
