Report of the Auditor General on the Financial Statement of the South Eastern University of Sri Lanka for the year ended 31st December, 2009 in terms of Section 108 (2) of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978.

The audit of the financial statements of the South Eastern University of Sri Lanka for the year ended 31st December, 2009 was carried out under my direction in pursuance of provisions in Article 154 (1) of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka read in conjunction with sections 108 (1) and 111 of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978 and Sub-sections (3), (4) and (7) of section 13 of the Finance Act, No. 38 of 1971. This report is issued in terms of section 108 (2) of the Universities Act. A detailed report in terms of section 13 (7) (a) of Finance Act was issued to the Vice Chancellor of the University on 07th October, 2010.

1.2 Responsibility of the Management for the Financial Statements

Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these financial statements in accordance with Sri Lanka Accounting standards. This responsibility includes, designing, implementing and maintaining internal control relevant to the preparation and fair presentation of financial statements that are free from material misstatements, whether due to fraud or error; selecting and applying appropriate accounting policies, and making accounting estimates that are reasonable in the circumstances.

1.3 Scope of Audit and Basis of Opinion

My responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on my audit. Audit opinion, comments and findings in this report are based on review of the financial statement presented to audit and substantive tests of samples of transactions. The scope and extent of such review and test were such as to enable as wide audit coverage as possible within the limitations of staff, other resources and time available to me. The audit was carried out in accordance with Sri Lanka Auditing Standards to obtain reasonable assurance as to whether the financial statements are free from material misstatements. The audit includes the examination on a test basis of evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in financial statements and assessment of accounting policies used and significant estimates made by the management in the preparation of financial statement as well as evaluating their overall presentation. I have obtained sufficient information and explanations which to the best of my knowledge and belief were necessary for the purpose of my audit. I therefore, believe that my audit provides a reasonable basis for my opinion. Sub-sections (3) and (4) of Section 13 of the Finance Act, No. 38 of 1971 give discretionary powers to the Auditor General to determine the scope and extent of the audit.

2. Financial Statements

2.1 Opinion

So far as appears from my examination and to the best of information and according to the explanations given to me, I am of opinion that, the South Eastern University of Sri Lanka had maintained proper accounting records for the year ended 31st December, 2009 and except for the effects on the financial statements of the matters referred to in paragraph 2.2 of this report, the financial statements have been prepared and presented in accordance with the Sri Lanka Accounting Standards give a true and fair view of the state of affairs of the University as at 31st December, 2009 and the financial results of its operations and cash flows for the year ended.

2.2 Comments on Financial Statements

2.2.1 Accounting Policies

The value of the land had not been ascertained and brought to account and as a result the fixed assets had been understated.

2.2.2 Accounting Deficiencies

The following accounting deficiencies were observed.

- (a) Fence to the value of Rs. 326,211 which had been demolished for the construction of parapet wall had not been eliminated from the Fence Account. Hence, the fence account had been overstated by the same amount.
- (b) Provision had not been made for audit fees amounting Rs. 200,000 for the year under review.

- (c) Direct debits and credits totalling Rs. 1,266,666 and Rs. 183,959 respectively shown in certain bank reconciliation statements had not been investigated and brought to accounts.
- (d) Depreciation had been understated in the accounts by Rs. 61,874,695.
- (e) Telephone charges amounting to Rs. 20,135 recoverable from 03 officers had been shown as expenditure instead of being shown as dues to the University during the year under review.
- (f) Hostel fees receivable amounting to Rs. 30,008 for the year under review had not been brought to accounts.
- (g) Interest on memorial funds amounting to Rs. 25,644 had not been brought to accounts as operating revenue.
- (h) A sum of Rs. 100,406 had been overstated in the Violation of Bond account for the year under review.

2.2.3 Accounts Receivable and Payable

Following observations are made.

- (a) A sum of Rs. 41,962 paid as vehicle loan had not been recovered for over 12 years from the relevant officer.
- (b) A sum of Rs. 103,000 paid to 02 officers as computer loan had not been recovered for the period ranging from 3 to 8 years.
- (c) A sum of Rs. 58,261 paid to 02 officers as Motor Bicycle loan had not been recovered for over 3 years.
- (d) A sum of Rs. 26,650 paid as Festival and Special Loans to the officers had not been recovered for over 3 years.
- (e) Advances amounting to Rs. 11,993 given for purchases of office items had not been settled for the period ranging from 2 to 8 years.
- (f) Advances amounting to Rs. 53,001 given to purchases of books had not been settled for the period ranging from 01 to 05 years.
- (g) Salary advances amounting to Rs. 26,922 had not been recovered from the officers concerned for over one year.

2.2.4 Lack of Evidence for Audit

Following observations are made:-

- (a) Five items in the accounts aggregating Rs. 767,673,257 could not be satisfactorily vouched in audit in the absence of valuation reports, Board of Survey reports, verification reports and detailed Schedules;
- (b) Schedule of depreciation had not been prepared according to the Sri Lanka Accounting Standards No. 08.

2.2.5 Non-compliance with Laws, Rules Regulations and Management Decisions

Several provisions in the following Laws, Financial Regulations and Establishments Code for the University Grants Commission and Higher Educational Institutions, Public Administration Circulars, and Sri Lanka Accounting Standards had not been complied with –

- (a) Sections 109 and 110 of the Universities Act, No. 16 of 1978;
- (b) Sri Lanka Accounting Standard No. 18;

3. Financial and Operating Review:-

According to the financial statements presented, the working of the University for the year ended 31st December, 2009 had resulted in a deficit of Rs. 320,006,294 as compared with the corresponding deficit of Rs. 354,460,840 for the preceding year. After taking into account the Government Grant of Rs. 270,596,382 received for the recurrent expenditure the deficit had reduced to Rs. 49,409,912 for the year under review as compared with the corresponding deficit of Rs. 102,622,862 for the preceding year after taking into account the Government Grant of Rs. 251,837,978 for the recurrent expenditure for that year. Thus indicating an improvement of Rs. 53,212,950 in the financial result.

3.2 Performance Review

3.2.1 Cost per Student

According to the information made available to audit, the average cost per student for the year under review is shown below:-

3.2.3 Delays in Projects

A sum of Rs. 16,866,550 had been paid to a Company for consultancy service during the year 2006 for the preparation of preliminary master plan of the University. However, no consultancy report had been obtained by the University up to the end of the year 2009.

3.2.4 Assets Management

Following observations are made :-

- (a) Seven Consumable items to the value of Rs. 391,688 had been idling for over 5 years;
- (b) A sum of Rs. 242,850 had been paid for the purchase of Cloaks for Master Degree and PHD degree during 2001 to 2008 without starting Master Degree Courses up to end of the year under review.

3.2.5 Uneconomic Transactions

Following observations are made:-

- (a) A sum of Rs. 516,320 had been spent as advertisement charges for more than one papers in the same language;
- (b) Out of the funds allocated for the educational development activities, a sum of Rs. 1,235,934 had been incurred during the year under review to provide meals and refreshments to the participants of meetings and welfare gatherings without spending education development activities.

3.2.6 Audit and Management Committee

An Audit and Management Committee had not been established.

3.2.7 Budgetary Control

Major variations were observed between the budgeted expenditure and actual expenditure, thus indicating that the Budget had not been made use of as an effective instrument of management control.
