I, as the Minister of Local Government at Sabaragamuwa Province, Mahipala Herath to shall hereby notify under the power vested as the relevant minister for the subject for me Article No. 2(1) of Provincial Councils Act, No. 12 of 1989 have approved the By-laws which have been prepared by the Kuruwita Pradeshiya Sabha under the power vested for it by the Article No. 122(1) 69/126 of Local Authority Act, No. 15 of 1987 and shaped be connected within the limit of Local Authority from the date that notification appeared in the *Gazette of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka*.

#### BY-LAWS ON REGULARISATION OF CONTROLLING THE DISPLAY OF PROPAGANDA ADVERTISEMENTS – KURUWITA PRADESHIYA SABHA

1. These By-laws are known as the by-laws of regularisation of controlling the display of propaganda advertisements within the authority area of Kuruwita Pradeshiya Sabha.

2. Henceforth no one shall display or cause to display any propaganda advertisement seemingly to any street, road, canal or air without a permit obtained from the Chairman.

3. Every application which is submitted under these by-laws should consists the following things :-

- (a) A written application addressed to the secretary ;
- (b) A ground plan drawn to the scale not less than 1:1000 ;
- (c) A sketch of the creation drawn to the scale not less than 1:1000 ;
- (d) Any amendments made to that plan, sketch or specification in order to consistent with these by-laws ;
- (e) A copy of that advertisement to be displayed which is drawn to a smaller scale with all the colours ;
- (f) A ground plan of the propaganda advertisement with adjacent streets and land marks ;
- (g) For the purpose of giving permission to display a propaganda advertisement/board, following documents are required by the Pradeshiya Sabha :-
  - (i) A letter of consent obtained from the owner of the land where propaganda advertisement or board is fixed ;
  - (ii) If it is a road reservation, a letter of permission obtained from the Road Development Authority ;
  - (iii) If it is an expressway, a letter of permission obtained from the Environmental and Landscape Division of the Urban Development Authority.

4. All the applications to get a permit under the 2nd By-law of the above, should be submitted to the Secretary of the Pradeshiya Sabha at least seven days prior to the display of advertisement.

5. No one shall cause to erect any board to display a propaganda advertisement, wall board, notice board or any other structure except according to the plans, diagrams and specifications as written approval of the Pradeshiya Sabha.

6. Where an application is approved by the Pradeshiya Sabha, the applicant shall not be issued a permit until he pay the taxes as mentioned in the 1st Schedule hereto.

7. Any person who receives a permit, shall not display the advertisements other than the specified places in the 2nd Schedule hereto.

8. Where a permit is issued to any person, the Pradeshiya Sabha may order him to put the name of the permit holder and reference number of the permit on every advertisement to be displayed.

9. The charges mentioned in the 1st Schedule below are not applicable to the below “a” to “e” items and to the aerial name boards :–
- (a) A notice belongs to any concert which the net income received uses for charity ;
  - (b) A display of a propaganda advertisement regarding to any concert where such concert is held ;
  - (c) A display of a propaganda advertisement regarding religious, political or public rally ;
  - (d) House name boards not exceeding size of 30x15 ;
  - (e) A name board for professional activities which is not exceeding 0.093m. ;
  - (f) A propaganda advertisement on a vehicle, with the name, address and phone or telex Nos., which is used for a trade or business activity.
10. The owner, lessee or advertiser shall take a permit from the Pradeshiya Sabha by paying the required charges if the wall board, notice board or any other structure of a business premises under these by-laws includes a trade name of any goods or services, brands and diagrams other than the business name, address, registered number, telephone number or telex number.
11. (i) No person shall display a propaganda advertisement over or so as to project towards a road or foot path or a street.  
(ii) Display of a propaganda advertisement on a board at a height exceeding 12 meters from the ground.  
(iii) Fix or hang a propaganda advertisement which is longer than the facade of an adjoining building which faces a street or a road in the facade of that building or in the name board of a trade stall.  
(iv) A propaganda advertisement by nature of aerial name board shall not be erected without the prior approval of the Pradeshiya Sabha.
12. No person shall display a propaganda advertisement in a private or public building, a public sacred place, public park, bridge or passenger bridge over a road or on a telephone or electricity post, side wall, dam, weir, culvert, rock or on a tree.
13. No one shall display any propaganda advertisement on any notice board or name board which is erected or constructed in accordance with the manner approved by the Pradeshiya Sabha within the specified area by a resolution of the Pradeshiya Sabha and publish it in the *gazette*.
14. On any road or street within the authority area of the Kuruwita Pradeshiya Sabha, no one shall :–
- (i) carry or cause to carry any propaganda advertisement displayed on any board, frame, stand ;
  - (ii) use a radio, a gramophone, musical instrument, bell or any other instrument for the purpose of introducing or displaying propaganda advertisement.
15. (i) The Pradeshiya Sabha may order by written to stop the display of a propaganda advertisement when such advertisement is discolored, unpleasant or if it is displaying something contrary to the moral and public peace, if it is made of plastic or polythene which are not environmental friendly.  
(ii) Any one who has been rendered a notice under the Paragraph One of these by-laws, shall act according to the way stated there within a specified period of time.
16. Owner or lessee of any board that is used to display a propaganda advertisement :–
- (i) shall maintain in good repair ensuring the safety of property of the public ;
  - (ii) shall write clearly and legibly advertiser’s/lessee’s/owner’s name, address and the telephone number on the front side of the board.
17. No one shall distort or cause to distort any symbol, mark, letter, word or number which is placed on a propaganda advertisement by the Pradeshiya Sabha to show that the relevant levies have been paid.
18. (i) Within the authority area of the Kuruwita Pradeshiya Sabha, if any one is started, implementing, restarted or completed a task to display a propaganda advertisement without a permit issued by the Chairman or in contravention of the conditions in the permit, other than the remedies in these by-laws ; the owner or lessee shall be ordered by a written notice to :–
- (a) stop the display of the propaganda advertisement ; or
  - (b) destroy, erase or alter the propaganda advertisement within less than four days of the starting or implementing or completing of the task.

- (ii) Any person to whom a notice is given by the above section 18(1) shall take action as mentioned therein during the period prescribed or any extended period of time which is extended by the Pradeshiya Sabha on a request to do so.
- (iii) (a) If any person to whom a notice is given by the section 18(1) above violates to obey the said notice within an extended period of time, Pradeshiya Sabha may apply to the magistrate court having relevant jurisdiction praying an order to stop, destroy, alter, erase or remove such advertisement as the case may be.
- (b) If that person agrees to act in accordance with the notice of section 18(1) above and consider favourably to give him an opportunity to act so, the execution of the magistrate's order may be postponed to a period not exceeding one month.
19. Any person who violates the orders in these by-laws shall guilty of an offence and on being convicted by a Court of Law of proper jurisdiction shall be liable to a fine not exceeding Rs. 750 and in case he continues to commit that offence after a notice is given to him stating the violation, by a officer of the Pradeshiya Sabha, he shall be liable to an additional fine of Rs. 250 per day of committing the offence.
20. Unless the context otherwise requires "Sabha" means the "Kuruwita Pradeshiya Sabha", "Chairman" means the "Chairman of the Kuruwita Pradeshiya Sabha", "Secretary" means the "Secretary of the Kuruwita Pradeshiya Sabha", "Authorized Officer" means the "Technical Officer or Revenue Controller or any other officer of the Kuruwita Pradeshiya Sabha", "Propaganda Advertisement" means any message made of plastic wax cloth, metal, card board, paper, wood, cloths or any other material to address the public regarding any good or service using symbols, diagrams, characters or tableaux, "permit holder/advertiser" means an advertising agency or an institution producing the good or service.
21. In the event of any inconsistency between the Sinhala and Tamil text, of this statute, the Sinhala text shall prevail.
22. The Pradeshiya Sabha has the right to amend this statute from time to time.
