INDIVIDUAL and services eligible to submit bids.— Sealed bids are invited from Sri Lankans who are permanently residing in the Central Province or Sri Lankan firms, Co-operative Societies those which there registered offices are situated in the Central Province for the supply of cooked meals for the institutions stipulated in Column I of the Schedules 1, 2, 3 and 4 annexed herewith during the period of 01st January, 2013 to 31st December, 2013 (Including these two days.)

Bids for the Hospitals in Schedule No. 1 should be forwarded to the Chairman, Procurement Board of Central Provincial Health Ministry while the Schedule No. 2, 3, and 4 should be forwarded to the Chairman, Procurement Board of the Provincial Director of Health Services, Central Province.

- 02. *Bid documents.* Relevant Bid document could be obtained from the Provincial Director's office on payment of Non-refundable tender document fee is Rs. 500 and refundable deposit mentioned in Column 3 of Sub Schedule.
- 03. The following conditions 3.2 to 3.4 should be fulfilled by the below mentioned approved societies at the time of requesting their Procurement forms:—
 - 3.1 Approved societies:
 - (a) Sammurdhi Balakayas
 - (b) Multi purpose Co-operative Societies
 - (c) Rural Development Societies
 - (d) Registered Farmer Organizations.
 - 3.2 (a) The hospital should be situated within the area of authority of the societies and a letter from the Divisional Secretaries should be submitted to prove this
 - (b) (i) Rural Development Societies and Sammurdhi Balakayas should submit a certificate of financial position and certificate of eligibility of supplying cooked provision, to the hospitals obtained from the Divisional Secretaries.
 - (ii) Registered farmer organizations should submit the certificate of registration obtained from the Assistant Commissioner of Agrarian Services.

- 3.3 Multi-purpose Co-operative Societies can only submit tenders for supply foods to the hospitals situated within their area. They should submit a letter issue from the relevant bank, regarding the financial status (The account name should be the society's name)
- 3.4 All societies should submit their registration certificate along with the Bid documents.
- 3.5 Above mentioned societies can get special benefit if the hospital is situated in the relevant area. If not they will be considered as a normal applicants.
- 04. These approved societies will be allowed a preference up to 5% over the lowest Bids.
- 05. Issuing for Bid forms.— The Bids document for hospitals stipulated under Schedule 1, 2, 3 and 4 will be issued from 07th December, 2012 to 26th December, 2012 until 3.30 p. m. at Provincial Director of Health Services Office, Kandy.
- 06. *Declaration of assets.* All Bids when applying for Bids forms must submit acceptable of Assets issued by relevant Divisional Secretary after 01.10.2012 in the form of General 170. The value of the certificate of Assets should be as follows:—

Applications will not be issued to those Bidders who are failed to submit the certificate of Assets. Certificate of Assets should be produced along with the completed bid document according to the requirements, of hospitals.

07.Bid Applications shall be made only for the stated institutions at the time where the bid applications obtained. If a bid application obtained for a certain hospital shall not be made for another hospital. If do so such application will be rejected without opening it.If applied for procurement of approved registered societies, bid applications will be issued on the basis of ability certificate of financial value issued by the Divisional Secretary. No bid application willbe issued for society that does not possess such financial ability in any case.

- 08. Applying bids for more than one hospital, photocopy of the original certificate of Assets attested by JPO should be attached. Applications do not comply with above requirements will be rejected.
- 09. Numbers of Bids awarded for the hospitals would depend on the financial value of Assets. The decision will be final made by the board of procurement on this matter.
- 10. Following certificates should be submitted along with the bid document when Bids forms are obtained for District General Hospitals and District Base Hospitals, Dickoya, Teldeniya and Dambulla and Divisional Hospitals of Walapane, Udapussallawa and Maskeliya, Rikillagaskada:—
 - (a) Business Registration Certificate.
 - (b) Bank Statement for previous six months period (certified copies).
 - (c) Availability of storage and transport.
- 11. *Bid Bond.* A bid bond for all hospitals as mentioned for the amount in 3rd column of Schedule 1, 2, 3 and 4 refundable deposit should be paid and receipt should be obtained from the Provincial Director's office. Bid bonds are not necessary to submit by approved societies mentioned in 3.1 and 3.2(*a*). Bid Bonds are necessary to submit by societies mentioned in 3.5.
- 12.(a) Quantities.— Approximate quantities of supplies required are given in 6th column of the Schedule 1, 2, 3 & 4 and 5th column of the Schedule 5, 6, 7, 8 and 9 annexed herewith. (Price and rate should be submitted for one full diet for patient. (One full diet means breakfast, lunch and dinner).
- (b) Bidders should forward price and rate for all type of diets fresh fish, dry fish, chicken, eggs, dhal with vegetables. As an economy measure the Department may decide to substitute one of the diets in place of another. Viz. In lieu of an egg diet chicken diet or fresh fish or dry fish diet may be ordered if this is cheaper than that. However a vegetable diet cannot be ordered in lieu of an egg, chicken, fresh fish or dryfish diet. Contractor should note well that an egg or chicken or fish should be supplied for lunch and vegetable with dhal for dinner and Bidders should be prepared to supply accordingly. Meanwhile for breakfast every day in week Red rice with dhal (uncooked rice 75g. dhal 15g.), Milk rice with Lunumiris (rice 75g). Munata with lunumiris (munata 90g.) Bread 120g with 1 plantain (120g), Kadala with lunumiris (kadala 90g.) and contractors should prepared to supply any other nutrient meal except bread for low rates.
- (c) In an instances where a diet or several diets not supplied, the expenses of the diet supplied by the favour of the head of the institution will be deduct from the contractors bill.
- (d) One diet means supplying of breakfast, lunch and dinner for patients (3 meals per day).
- (e) Price and rates should be submitted according to Schedule No. 05 and 06 for residential patients in Digana Rehabilitation Hospital.
- (f) For Tuberculosis patients at General Hospital, Matale should be provided foods according to Schedule No. 07.

- (g) For mental patients at General Hospital, Matale should be provided foods according to Schedule No. 08.
- (h) For patients at Sisila mental rehabilitation hospital, Deltota should be provided food according to Schedule No. 09.
- 13. (1) Forwarding Bids.—Tenders for the hospitals mentiond in Schedule No. 1 should be forwarded in two copies each copy should be enclosed in separate sealed envelopes and send both the copies in one cover to the Secretary, Ministry of Health, Indigenous Medicine, Social Welfare, Probation & Child Care Services, P. O. Box 121, Sangaraja Mawatha, Kandy. The cover enclosing the tender should bare at the top left corner the nature of the services of diet contract "Tender to supply cooked provisions for the Hospital in District 2013" at the top left corner the name and the address of the tenderer should be written clearly. The cover enclosing the sealed Tender may be sent by registered post or deposited in the Bid box at office of the Ministry of Health Services Kandy. Any responsibility will not be taken regarding postal delays.
- (11) Forwarding Bids.— Tenders for the hospitals mentioned in Schedule No. 2, 3 and 4 should be forwarded in two copies each copy should be enclosed in separate sealed envelopes and send both the copies in one cover to the Provincial Director of Health, Services, Office of the Provincial Director of Health Services, P. - 14. (I) Accepting of Bids.— For the Nawalapitiya and Matale District General Hospital Bid forms would be accepted with the Date Stamp from the Office of Ministry of Health Services on 28th December 2012 until 10.30 a.m. Bid applications will be opened at 11.a.m. on the same date.
- (II) Accepting of Bids.— For the other hospitals (except Nawalapitiya and Matale District General Hospitals) Bid forms would be accepted with the Date Stamp from the Office of the Provincial Director of Health Services on 28th December 2012 until 10.30 a.m. Bid applications will be opened at 11.a.m. on the same date.
- 15. Bidders or authorized person can be presented on the time of opening of the tender.
- 16. Decision of Bidders.— The total cost of the services arrived at on the rates quoted for item in Schedule "A" diets in the Bids form will be the basis for a decision on the Bids received. The tender should however quote for items in Schedule "C" in the tender form. But the prices to be paid shall be rates quoted in the tender or prevailing market rate or rates submitted by the Divisional Secretary. The lowest price of those will be selected. If such items have control price; payments will be made in accordance with the control price. Bids procedure of supply of cooked provision will be subjected to amend regulation tax and various statuses, which are issued by the

Government from time to time. Final Bids decision will be taken by the secretary of the Ministry of Health Central Province/Provincial Director of Health Services, Central Province/the Director Board of procurement of the relevant District Health Services.

- 17. *Validity of Bid Rates.* The rates quoted by the Bids should be valid for the period of contract mentioned in paragraph 1 above and under no circumstances will the rates be permitted to be varied during such period, unless specifically provided for in the agreement.
- 18. Security Deposits.— The selected tenders will be required to sign agreement. In addition to that a performance bond (issued by a reputed bank which is accepted by Central Bank) should be submitted for 10% of full tender amount. Contractors who did not work under the relevant agreement in first month will not be paid any payment and would like to inform that their names will be entered in the black list.
- 19. *Storage Accommodation.* Successful Bidders will not be provided the facilities in the nature of store room, or in the institution or within its premises.
- 20. Bids Conditions.— Prospective tenders should study the Bids conditions on the reverse of the Bids forms and comply with requirements therein. Bidders should also note the conditions of the agreement in the Bids form.
- 21. Supply of type and quantity of rice.— The rates quoted by Bidders should be for the supply of two rice meals of 100 grams for each patient. The permitted red rice should be supplied for meals.
 - 22. Bid forms will not be issued for the black listed Bidders or Societies. The decision of the Procurement Board will be the final decision.
