OPEN COMPETITIVE EXAMINATION TO RECRUIT IN TO CLASS III OF THE NORTH CENTRAL PROVINCIAL PUBLIC MANAGEMENT ASSISTANT SERVICE - 2013

APPLICATIONS are called from those who possess suitable qualifications for the Open Competitive Examination to be held to make recruitment to Posts in Class III of the North Central Provincial Public Management Assistant Service. The closing date of applications is 03rd of June, 2013.

02. Taking into Consideration the merit of the results of the written examination held by the Sri Lanka Examination Department, Candidates who have fulfilled the qualifications will be selected for appointment to this post based on the population ratio of the Districts in the North Central Province in accordance with the Public Administration Circular No. 15/90, After confirmation of the qualifications.

03. North Central Provincial Public Service Commission will decide on the number to be appointed and the effective date of the appointments. North Central Provincial Public Service Commission reserves the right to make a final decision on this matter.

04. *Salary* .— In accordance with the Public Administration Circular Number 06/2006(IV) dated 24.08.2007 the salary scale relevant to class III, II and I is Rs. 13,990-10x145-11x170-6x240-14x320- Rs. 23,230 to proceed above Rs. 15,440 promotion to class II has to be obtained and to proceed above Rs. 17,310 promotion to class I has to be obtained.

05. 05.1 This post is Permanent and Pensionable, Liable to make contributions to widows, Widower and orphans pension fund in accordance with Public Administration Circular No. 06/2006.
- 05.2 Should obtain Proficiency in an additional language/languages other than the medium of language in which he/she has joined the service within 05 years of recruitment to the service in accordance with Public Administration Circular No. 07/2007 dated 28.05.2007.
- 05.3 The appointee is compulsorily bound to serve at any Service station in the North Central Province for a period of 3 years. Any request made to get released from that post within that period will never be considered.

06. *Qualifications* .— For recruitment to Posts in Class III of the North Central Provincial Management Assistant Service, the qualifications mentioned below are relevant:—

- (a) Applicant should be a Citizen of Sri Lanka.
- (b) The age should not be less than 18 years or more than 30 years to the closing date of applications (to 3rd of June, 2013). (The maximum age limit will not apply to those who are already holding permanent posts in Public/Provincial Public Service.)
- (c) Should bear a good Character.
- (d) Should have fulfilled the following Educational Qualifications:—
- I. Should have passed the General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) examination in Six (6) Subjects with Four (4) Credit passes including Sinhala/Tamil/English and Arithmetic in one sitting;
- and
- II. Should have passed the General Certificate of Education (Advance Level) in all the subjects excepting General Common Test and General English in one sitting (Passing in three subjects in one sitting under the old syllabus is adequate.)

07. Selection on the basis of District Population Ratio:—

- I. In accordance with the population ratio of the above mentioned Districts and the Public Administration Circular No. 15/90, a specific number will be reserved for each district from vacancies existing. If the number of vacancies thus reserved for a district population ratio system is not filled within that district such number of vacancies will be redistributed among the adjoining districts in the province.
 - II. When the number of candidates who had managed to obtain the maximum number of mark to pass the examination is below the number of the existing number of vacancies making selections on the basis of district population ratio will not be practised.
- (a) Criteria for Permanent Residence :
- I. Should confirm to have Permanent Residence in the North Central Province in Anuradhapura and Polonnaruwa District) for 03 successive years within the 05 year period immediately prior to the closing date of applications. For residence confirmation documents mentioned below should be produced at the interview.
 - II. Residence Certificate issued by the Grama Niladhari Counter signed by the Divisional Secretary (Full name, number in the electoral list and details on registration which are the details necessary to confirm residence through electoral name list in column 2(a) and 2(ii) of that certificate have to be mentioned.

08. *Examination Procedure* .— The Open Competitive Examination for recruitment will be conducted by the Commissioner General of Examinations. This Competitive Examination comprises two question papers. The examination will be conducted in Sinhala, Tamil and English Media. Medium applied will not be allowed to change later.

<i>Question Paper</i>	<i>Marks</i>	<i>Time</i>
I. Language Proficiency	100	1 1/2 hours
II. Aptitude	100	1 hour

Language Proficiency .— This question paper will contain questions to assess the candidates knowledge in expression of ideas, comprehension, correct spelling and simple grammar, All the questions have to be answered.

Aptitude .— This question paper will contain questions designed to assess the candidates' knowledge in numerical skill, sound reasoning, general intelligence etc. It will contain 50 questions similar to multiple choice and short answer type questions. All the questions have to be answered.

09. *To become eligible for appointments* .— candidates should receive at least forty percent (40%) out of the marks allocated for each subject, and fifty percent (50%) out of the total marks of the examination. By strictly following the ratio rule to fill the vacancies received, in accordance with the order of the marks received, an interview will be held to get the qualifications confirmed, stipulated in paragraph 06 above.

10. From the existing number of vacancies 3% has been reserved for disabled persons. To award appointments only to 3% of the vacancies to the disabled who qualify at the examination receiving high marks levels they should have the qualifications given in paragraph 09 above. Those who are qualified thus, will be referred to a special Medical Board. Selections will be made after confirmation by the special Medical report on the person's disabled condition and that the condition will not be a hindrance for the performance of the duties of the relevant post.

11. *Punishments for providing false information* .— It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide true information on his qualifications. When one fills one's application form one should be vigilant to provide information correctly. In accordance with the rules of this examination, if it comes to light that a candidate is not eligible, his/her candidacy can be cancelled at any stage, before the examination or while the examination is in progress or after the examination. If it is revealed at any stage that any information forwarded by a candidate is incorrect he/she can be dismissed from public service. Candidates are subject to the rules and regulations imposed by the Commissioner General of Examinations with regard to the holding of the examination. In case such rules and regulations are violated he or she will have to face a punishment imposed by the Commissioner General of Examinations.

12. *Examination fees*.— Every candidates has to pay an examination fee to the North Central Provincial Council. the examination fee is Rs. 600. Paying this fee in cash to any North Central Provincial Ministry Office/department (Excepting local government bodies) any Divisional Secretariat Office in North Central Provincial and the receipt NC 100 obtained therefore should be annexed to the application. Under no circumstances would the examination fee paid be refunded. (A photostat copy of the receipt obtained for the payment and a photostat copy of the application should be retained with the applicant)

13. *Application* .— The application should be prepared in accordance with the specimen form shown at the end of this notice using both sides of an A-4 (21x29 cm) (Ordinary half sheet) size paper.

- (a) indicating Paragraphs 01 to 3.4 on the first page; and
- (b) 04 and the following paragraphs on pages three and four application should be prepared by the applicant himself/herself and filled by his/her own hand writing and signed.
- (c) When applications are prepared in Sinhala or Tamil in addition to the heading in Sinhala or Tamil, the English heading should also be given.
- (d) Disabled applicants should write clearly the words "A disabled applicant" and indicate the nature of the disability on top of the application in red. A certified copy of the medical certificate confirming the nature of the disability should be attached.
- (e) Photostat copies of the Educational certificates that confirm the qualifications given under paragraph 06 above should be attached to the application. Applications not prepared to confirm to the specimen form given in this notification, not forwarded after paying the examination fee before the due date, where fees had been paid to other institutions, fail to become eligible with the educational certificates forwarded, not properly and clearly filled and those which are incomplete will be rejected without adducing any reason. The loss caused by not filling the application properly should be borne by the applicant. The application that is furnished should be prepared exactly to confirm to the form shown in this notification. If not, it is likely that the application will be rejected.

13.2 Assuming that only those who had qualifications stipulated in the *Gazette notification* had applied, the Commissioner General of Examination will allow all those applicants who had paid the due examination fee and had sent in their applications on or before the due date to sit the Competitive examination. The mere issuance of an Admission Card to appear for the Competitive Examination will not be considered as an acknowledgement that the candidate has fulfilled the qualifications for this post. After having called for the

interview if it is found that the applicant does not have the qualifications needed at the time the qualifications are checked in accordance with the *gazette* notification, his/her candidacy will be cancelled. If it comes to light after candidate is selected/appointed, he will be subject to dismissal from service.

13.3. The application correctly filled should be sent (with a photostat copy) under registered cover on or before 3rd of June, 2013 to the address “Secretary, Provincial Public Service Commission, North Central Province, Anuradhapura”. On the top left hand corner of the envelope enclosing the applications, the phrase “Open competitive Examination to recruit to class III of the North Central Provincial Public Management Assistant Service - 2013” and the name of the district relevant to you should be written. 13.4 Candidate’s signature should be attested and placed his/her official stamp by a principal of a government school/a justice of the peace/ a commissioner of oaths/a notary public/ an authorized officer of the armed forces/officer holding a *gazetted* post in the police or provincial public service drawing a salary of Rs. 240,360 or above. It is compulsory that applicants from public/provincial public service should forward his/her application through his/her head of department.

14. Admission card to appear for the examination will be issued by the Commissioner General of Examinations at least one week ahead of the date of the examination. Without such an admission card no person will be allowed to sit the examination. It would be more appropriate if a certified copy of the application you had retained with you, certified copy of the payment receipt, registration receipt and a fax number to send the admission card if the place is away from Colombo are also sent along with your letter to the Sri Lanka Examination Department.
