- (iv) applicant should possess a sound character and in good health.
- (v) should be a person not convicted in a court of law under the penal code or a person dismissed from the government service or provincial government service.

04. *Conditions of service :*

- (i) This post is permanent and pensionable.
- (ii) The permanent appointment is subject to a probationary period of 03 years.

(iii) Should be in conformity with official language policy.
