AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE GREEN BUILDING COUNCIL OF SRI LANKA

I, Ranjith Bandara do hereby give notice under standing Order No. 48(1) of the Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka, that I propose to introduce in parliament a Bill entitled "An Act, to Incorporate the Green Building Council of Sri Lanka".

The aim of the Bill is to incorporate the said organisation which has the following general objects :

1. To promote and develop the principles, techniques, guidelines, rating systems and practices for making the build environment green and sustainable ; and awarding certificates to the relevant parties by certifying the level of environment performance of buildings, building materials, cities or infrastructures developments etc.
2. To promote and inculcate Green Building Practices, among all stakeholders in the building industry, namely

building owners, users, developers, builders, investors, building industry professionals and government and non-governmental agencies responsible for building construction, the practice of creating structures and using processes that a environmentally responsible and resource-efficient throughout a building's life-cycle; from sitting to: design, construction, operation, maintenance, renovation and deconstruction. This practice will expand and complement the classical building design concerns of economy, utility, durability and comfort.

3. To conduct courses and examinations qualifying for awarding associate or accredited professional status of the Green Building Council of Sri Lanka, to test the competence of persons engaged in green construction and to grant certificates of competence.
