A Bill to amend the Young Men's Buddhist Association Maharagama (Incorporation) Act, No. 19 of 1998

I hereby give notice under Standing Order No. 53(1) of Standing Orders of Parliament of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka that I intend to present a Bill in Parliament titled "A Bill to amend the Young Men's Buddhist Association, Maharagama (Incorporation) Act, No. 19 of 1998.

The Objectives of the Bill are to introduce the following amendments to the Principal enactment.

- (1) Substitution for the words "Board of Management" of the words "Working Board" wherever the words "Board of Management" are.
- (2) Amendment of Section 5 of the principal enactment by substituting for the words "Chairman, three vice chairmen, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer and twenty four other members" of the words "Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Deputy Chairman, Deputy Secretary, Deputy Treasurer, three Vice Chairmen, three Vice Secretaries, three Vice Treasurers and twenty four other members".
