Press and from the date of publication, thereby enabling those interested in the contents of such Notices to actively and positively participate please note that inquiries and complaints made in respect of corrections pertaining to notification will not be entertained after **three months** from the date of publication.

RESOLUTION

“Under Section 3 of the Pradeshiya Sabha Act, No. 15 of 1987, the maintenance of public utility services, protection of all facilities, and implementation of development activities have been determined as functions of the Pradeshiya Sabhas. Therefore, the Manmunai West Pradeshiya Sabha has resolved to levy the service charges specified in the following schedule in relation to the provision of services at the Vavunathivu Public Market during the year 2026, and to implement and follow these procedure accordingly.”

PROCEDURES OF THE VAVUNATHEEVU PUBLIC MARKET

With the objective of regulating the internal and external trading activities of the Vavunatheevu Public Market belonging to the Pradeshiya Sabha, the following information is hereby published for public attention.

1. Trading activities may be carried out on market days without causing obstruction to traffic, on both sides of the main road extending from the entrance gate area of the Vavunatheevu Public Market up to the framers' market junction (roundabout) on the eastern side for a distance of 116 meters and on the Western Side up to the Police Station junction roundabout for a distance of 102 meters.
2. The Vavunatheevu Public Market shall function every Tuesday, and allocations of spaces inside and outside the market shall be made according to the nature of the trade on the basis stated below:

3. Only one shop shall be allocated to one trader. Requesting additional shops through assistants, relatives, or other persons is strictly prohibited. If an additional shop is required, it must first be discussed with the lessee and obtained accordingly. If such an additional shop cannot be obtained in that manner, a written request must be submitted to us. The final decision regarding the allocation of any additional shop shall be taken by the Sabha.
4. No permanent stalls shall be allocated within the market, and stalls shall be allocated on a *first-come, first-served basis*.
5. Any complaints relating to issues arising among traders and the general public within the market shall be submitted in writing to the Sabha through the market lessee. Complaints relating to the lessee shall be directly submitted in writing to the Sabha.
6. It is strictly prohibited to carry out trading activities in areas adjacent to the market during the two days prior to the market day.
7. No person shall in any manner damage or interfere with any property constructed or installed within the market premises.
8. The following activities shall not be carried out within the market area :
 - (a) Selling, displaying, or placing goods in passages allocated for the movement of the public for the purpose of purchasing goods.
 - (b) Begging.
 - (c) Behaving disorderly or causing any form of nuisance or disturbance to others.
9. Traders who violate the above-mentioned conditions shall be removed from the market premises without prior notice.
10. The authority for supervision, regulation, and administration of the public market rests with the Pradeshiya Sabha. Accordingly, all final decisions and procedures relating to the market shall be implemented by the Pradeshiya Sabha, and all traders shall comply with such decisions.
11. The Chairman or Officers authorized by him may enter the market premises at any time for the purpose of inspecting and supervising whether trading activities are conducted in accordance with these by-laws. During such instances, no person shall obstruct or interfere with such duties.
