01. **Post:** Firefighter

07. **Nature of the post:**

This post is permanent. You must also contribute to the Widows and Orphans Pension Scheme. You must pay contributions for it as prescribed by the Government from time to time. Firefighters who are recruited as apprentice Firefighters and successfully complete the one – year training course will be permanently recruited to the post of Firefighter.

08. **Duties:**

In accordance with the laws of the Kaluthara Municipal Council, the duties assigned to the position to save lives and property in the event of fire and other disasters and the duties assigned by the Head of the Institution in relation to the position.

09. **Educational Qualifications:**

Must have passed the General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) Examination in six (06) subjects with credit passes in four subjects including Sinhala/Tamil Language and Mathematics and must have passed Science and English Language at the same time or at an additional sitting.

10. **Physical Qualifications:**

I. Height not less than 162cm and BMI as prescribed.(BMI 18.5 to 24)

II. Must be physically and mentally fit enough to serve in any part of the island and to perform the duties of the position.

III. *Vision Requirements* - Vision without glasses or contact lenses should be at least between 6/6 and 6/12, with normal color vision.

IV. Must not have undergone artificial physical modifications (e.g. tattoos)

11. **Age Limit:**

The minimum age limit should not be less than 18 years and the maximum age limit should not be more than 24 years.

12. **Other:**

I. Must be a citizen of Sri Lanka

II. Must be a permanent resident of the Western Province for 03 consecutive years immediately preceeding the closing date for applications.

III. Must be an unmarried male

IV. Must be of good character and must submit a police report to prove that he has not been involved in any illegal activities.

13.(e) General interview

- This will be conducted to ckeck basic qualifications. No marks.
- iv. Those selected for the vacancies must complete a one - year firefighter training course. Firefighters whose work conduct and attendance are not satisfactory during the training period or who do not reach the expected the level of employment will be removed from training without any compensation.

- v. Apprentice firefighters who successfully complete the relevant training will be permanently recruited to firefighter positions. The training period will be counted towards the period of permanent service and will be placed in the second step of the relevant salary scale.
- vi. A monthly allowance of Rs. 10,000.00 will be paid during the training period.
- vii. No apprentice firefighter will be permitted to marry during the training period.
- viii. The apprentice firefighters selected for training should sign a bond worth Rs. 500,000.00 with the appointing authority at the time of commencement of training, stating that they will serve the Kalutara Municipal Council for a period of 05 years from the date of appointment after being appointed to a permanent position.
- ix. If the candidate withdraws from the training during the training period, all expenses incurred by the Kaluthara Municipal council for the training must be paid to the institute.
- x. Appointments to fire brigade posts may be required to reside within the Kalutara Municipal Council area.

14. Application method:
